Promoting Democracy in Yugoslavia

- The U.S. Government should increase sharply its support for democracy in Yugoslavia from the current level of \$15 million to \$35 million this fiscal year.
- This should be part of a broad diplomatic initiative aimed at developing alternatives to the authoritarian regime in Belgrade and broadening the West's range of contacts.
- One focus should be development of a new generation of leaders who respect political pluralism, rule of law and tolerance.
- This effort should include a reinvigorated public affairs stance: the people of Yugoslavia deserve better than the current authoritarian regime.

Focus on democratic institutions

Open media

\$10 million

- Extend the audience of open media (TV, radio and print) by providing needed antennas, satellite links, computers and other infrastructure improvements
- Provide advice, technical support and professional education
- Fund legal protection for selected journalists and publications

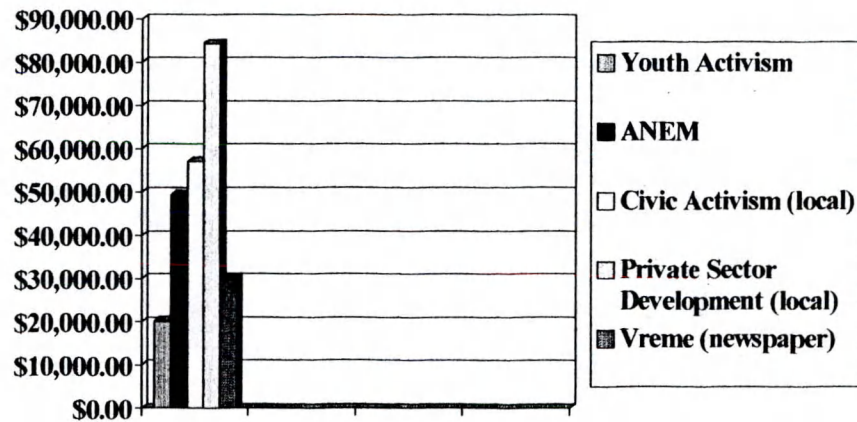

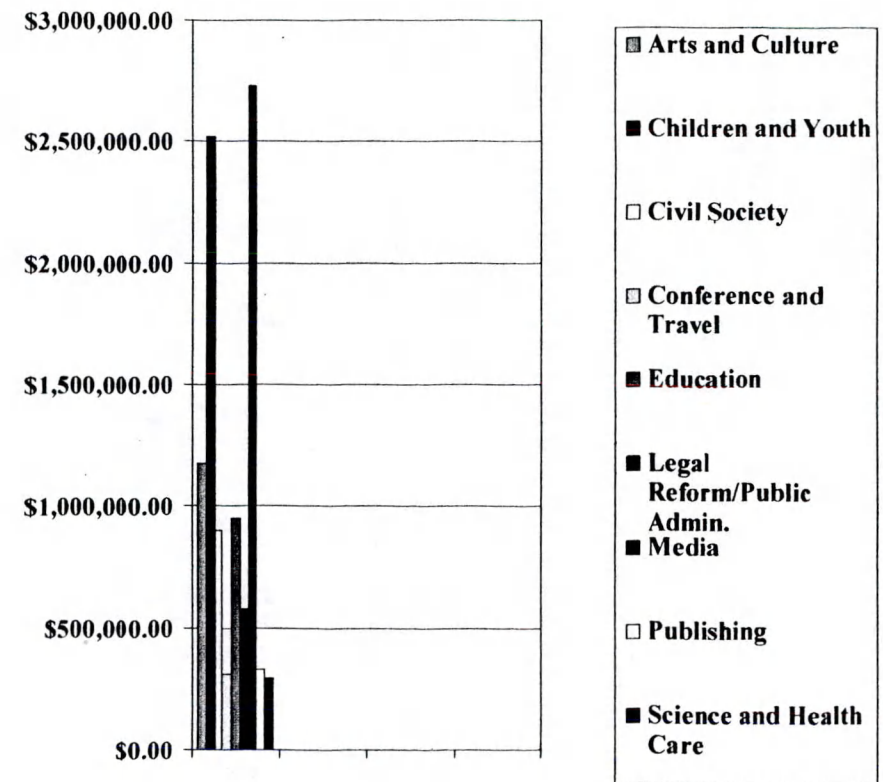

BIOGRAPHY

Dr Dragisa Burzan was born on the 13th of September, 1950 in Podgorica, Montenegro. He graduated from the School of Electrical Engineering, University of Podgorica. He received his masters at the University of Belgrade in quantum generators and his Ph.D. at the University of Essex, United Kingdom, in the theory of physics. Dr Burzan is a professor at the School of Mathematics, University of Montenegro.

He actively joined politics in 1989 as one of the founders of the "Democratic Alternative", a society of university professors whose goal was the implementation of democracy into the parliaments of the Republic of Montenegro and the former Yugoslavia. When the first multi-party elections were called (1989) the Democratic alternative joined the "Reform movement for Yugoslavia in Montenegro", whose leader was the last Yugoslav Prime Minister, Ante Markovic. In the summer of 1992 he participated in the formation of the Social Democratic Party of Reformists, which except for independent intellectuals also included some factions of the Reform movement of the former Yugoslavia. He was elected vice-president of the Socialist Democratic Party of Reformists at its founding congress. From 1992-1996 he was a Member of Parliament of the Republic of Montenegro. When the Social Democratic Party of Montenegro and the Social Democratic Party of Reformists merged in the summer of 1993, he was the Secretary for Foreign Affairs. At the party Congress in 1996 he was elected vice-president of the party, a position he holds to date (the Social Democratic Party of Montenegro has observer status in the Socialist Internationale (SI).

Mr. Ferhat Dinsa was born on the 13th of February 1954 in the village Dinsa, county of Podgorica, Republic of Montenegro.

In June 1978 he graduated from the University of Pristina, School of Languages and Literature. The same year he started writing for the Pristina based daily "Rilindia". He worked as a journalist, translator and in branches of the local government of the province of Kosovo, until Milosevic took power in Serbia when he moved back to his hometown, where he taught English in local schools until 1996.

In 1996, the Democratic Union of Albanians (DUA), participated in the Montenegrin parliamentary elections. He was elected a Member of Parliament to the Parliament of the Republic of Montenegro. He served as Minister without Portfolio in the transitional multi-party government of Mr Vujanovic from February 1998 to May 1998. He was responsible for human rights and ethnic communities. This was the first time that a member of a national Albanian party was a member of the government of the Republic of Montenegro.

At the extraordinary parliamentary elections, in May 1998, he led the list for the DUA and was once again elected a Member of Parliament of the Republic of Montenegro, continuing his career as a professional politician.

He is a member and one of the founders of the Montenegrin Helsinki Commission on Human Rights.
