VISIT TO PRAGUE'S OLD JEWISH CEMETERY

CONTEXT OF THE EVENT

You will visit the Cemetery (and the near-by Synagogue and museum) just before your series of bilaterals and the Plenary Lunch.

YOUR OBJECTIVES

- o To demonstrate respect for the once-vibrant Jewish presence in and contribution to Central European society and history.
- o To send an indirect message about tolerance by underscoring the multi-ethnic roots of Czech society, and every other society of Central and Eastern Europe.

CORE POINTS

- o These venerable sights are priceless reminders of the great Jewish community of Central Europe that thrived for centuries. Millions of Americans trace their heritage to Prague, Warsaw, Budapest, Bratislava, Krakow, Vilnius, Minsk, Lvov, Kiev and other cities and small towns of Europe's heart.
- o This neighborhood -- recalling the ancient roots of Jewish life in this city -- reminds us of the rich, multi-ethnic character of Central European society. Even as we remember the terrible destruction of Jewish life in Central Europe in this century, let us honor the previous centuries of work, life, love and achievement, as well as hardship, that this place represents.

BACKGROUND

The old Jewish cemetery, located in the Old Town, is part of the small complex of sites that make up the heart of the historical Jewish community in Prague. The Old Jewish Ghetto, which occupied much of the surrounding area, was cleared at the turn of the 20th century. Only this small Jewish neighborhood retains some of the medieval flavor of the Old Ghetto.

The Cemetery was used from medieval to early modern times, though the oldest surviving tombstone date from the 15th century. It became so crowded that bodies were buried up to a dozen deep; that is why the tombstones crowd one another at odd angles and give the cemetery its "haunted" look.

The most famous grave dated from the early 17th century: that of Rabbi Loew, a contemporary and acquaintance of Emperor Rudolf II. According to legend, Rabbi Loew created the Golem, a man made of clay, whose remains are still reputed to be locked in the attic of one of the synagogues in the area.

Next to the cemetery is the Jewish State Museum, which contains a collection of drawings by children from all over Europe who were interned at the concentration camp in Terezin (Theresienstadt), an hour's drive north of Prague.

At the nearby Jewish community center, Prague's small remaining Jewish community (estimated at 2,000, most of whom are elderly) have access to a kosher restaurant and other offices. The current Rabbi of the Prague congregation, Karel Sidon, took the post in 1992; he was a signer of Charter 77 and a dissident colleague of President Vaclav Havel in the 1970s and 1980s.

BACKGROUND
BUSINESS-RELATED EVENT AT K-MART

CONTEXT OF THE EVENT

Accompanied by Czech PM Klaus, you will visit K-Mart's flagship Prague outlet for a meeting with a small group of U.S. and Czech businessmen. The event will open with PM Klaus's introduction and your opening remarks of 4-5 minutes. From that point, the format will allow for remarks by some of the businessmen and informal exchanges -- a "reverse town meeting." This will be the final event in the Prague stop, and, with the partial exception of the walkabout with Havel the evening before, the major opportunity for unofficial exchanges.

YOUR OBJECTIVES

- o By balancing the theme of security with themes of economic reform, trade and investment, to underscore the U.S. commitment to the entire democratic and market reform process in Central and Eastern Europe.
- o To stress steps the U.S. is prepared to take to support increased levels of trade and investment with CEE.
- o To note that CEE countries themselves must be prepared to continue efforts to keep their markets open to trade and investment.

CORE POINTS

- o U.S. is committed to expanding the world's free community of democratic and free market nations. Central and Eastern Europe are second to none on our agenda.
- o Security underpinnings are key element of a free, democratic, reformed community. The NATO and Visegrad Summits -- decision to begin process of expanding NATO, PFP initiative -- marked major steps forward in advancing vision of a secure, undivided Europe; so will Moscow Summit.
- o Security is only one part of picture; reform's success depends on economic success, people's well being. Entrepreneurship will lead the way.
- o Trade and investment mean more than aid. U.S., West should, will do more.
 - I have urged EU to join U.S. in putting market access for CEE high on world's trade agenda. Look to G-7 Summit this year as chance to make progress.

- In 1994, [U.S./White House] will sponsor a special conference on trade and investment opportunities in Eastern and Central Europe.
 - OPIC will expand programs: accept proposals to establish private investment funds in the region; increase from \$50 million to \$200 million its project lending limit; will seek legislative authority to enable it to provide equity as part of a total project financing package.
 - Working bilaterally and through IFI's (World Bank, IMF, European Bank of Reconstruction and Development), U.S. will encourage regional cooperation, including by giving preference to regional projects, such as regional transportation projects.
- o Governments can do more as well.
- USG has learned hard way about need to reinvent government; CEE governments could think about ways to streamline procedures for investment, eliminate disincentives and barriers.
 - Businesses can, should, be good corporate citizens. Need a partner in government to do so.

BACKGROUND

K-Mart is in the top five U.S. investors in the Czech Republic and plans to invest a total of \$120 million. K-Mart announced its venture in the Czech Republic in May 1992, when it purchased 13 stores from the state-owned Prior chain. Six of these stores are in the Czech Republic, with the flagship store located in the heart of Prague.

The Czech venture is K-Mart's first retail investment outside the United States, Canada and Australia. The company's strategy is to recreate the K-Mart retailing advantage -- high-volume, low-cost, high quality, service-oriented operations in Central Europe. K-Mart has engaged its American training, supply, logistics, distribution and development partners to work on its Czech sites. K-Mart imports only 18 percent of its products sold in its Czech stores from the U.S; nevertheless, it is one of the country's largest importers of U.S. consumer goods.

In early stages of development and refurbishment of the Prague store, K-Mart's unionized employees (and K-Mart's only unionized employees worldwide) raised concerns about lay-offs, changes in management and K-Mart's philosophy. Some negative press reports appeared in Prague and tensions developed in Slovakia. Today, however, K-Mart appears to have worked out basic labor issues and the stores seem to function smoothly.
