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### **CICG Sub-Group Management Guidelines**

1. Each Sub-Group should be meeting frequently, as required in order to meet its taskings. Note that Sub-Group chairs will be expected to report on their progress directly to the CICG during full inter-agency meetings. The timing and location of Sub-Group meeting are at the discretion of the Chairperson(s).
2. To the maximum extent possible meetings should be announced 7-10 days in advance (with a proposed agenda) and scheduled so that the NSC Coordinator for the Sub-Group is able to attend each meeting together with the Chairperson(s). The Critical Infrastructure Assurance Office (CIAO) will: (a) maintain a master schedule of all meetings: and (b) circulate a biweekly calendar of upcoming events to all CICG Members and Sub-Group Chairpersons (as listed above) – any further distribution within each agency will be the responsibility of that agency. 3. A summary of conclusions should be prepared for each Sub-Group meeting and circulated to all participants within three working days of the meeting.
4. On a regular basis, reflecting the taskings of the CIGC, Sub-Group Chairpersons will brief the full CICG, providing updates on its activities, setting goals and objectives, describing milestones met, and identifying resource and other requirements. In addition, three months prior to every semi-annual review, Sub-Group Chairpersons will send an interim written report to the CICG Chairman, copy to all other CICG members.
5. The schedule for the first round of Sub-Group reports to the CICG was published initially in the June 11 draft CICG Work Program describing the Sub-Group organization and taskings.
6. Any CICG member and/or Sub-Group Chairperson changes should be communicated to the National Coordinator and the CIAO POC SFC Ben Pablo.

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
