SUBJECT: Presidential Decision Directive (PDD) on Somalia

The Small Group on 27 March reviewed the summary paper of PRD-5 "US Policy on Somalia." The Summary of Conclusions of that meeting is at Tab II. There is agreement on the PRD paper (Tab A).

I recommend that we send a proposed PDD to the President. Although not all PRDs require PDDs, the past and future U.S. military, assistance, and political involvement in Somalia justify having a formal policy.

SUBJECT: Small Group Meeting on Somalia, PRD-5 and
Pan Am 103 Sanctions

PRD-5 on Somalia is complete and is summarized in the attached paper. It produced 13 recommendations, with only one containing a minor disagreement.

Despite the consensus, we believe that it would be advisable to hold a Small Group meeting to review the PRD so that DC members are forced to address the issue. In many agencies, Somalia has not recently been the focus of concern above the Deputy Assistant Secretary level.

In the wake of President Mitterand's refusal to join in seeking new sanctions, we believe that we need a Small Group meeting on Pan Am 103 sanctions to review the future courses of action. The DC has not met yet to discuss this issue yet during this Administration.

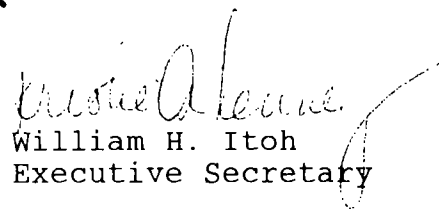
