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ROUGH ESTIMATE OF COSTS TO THE U.S. OF SOMALIA OPTIONS

Option 1 (Status quo with humanitarian improvements) -

FY 1993 costs of about \$250 million for food aid, transportation, refugee assistance, assessed UN contributions for peacekeeping operations. (3,500 troops)

Option 2 (Large UN force/ U.S. logistics assistance but no ground combat forces) -

Additional U.S. costs in FY 1993 to Option 1 of at least \$250 million if U.S. assessed normal share for 15,000 man force or if the U.S. makes a voluntary contribution to the UN of about 30% of the total cost of the operation. The value of U.S. logistical support could be counted toward the assessment. If either assessed or voluntary contributions from other countries do not occur, the U.S. could be at risk for the total cost which could approach \$1 billion for a full year.

Option 3 (U.S.-led military coalition) -

Additional U.S. costs in FY 1993 to Option 1 of at least \$600 million for six months and at least \$1 billion for full year of operation including incremental costs of special pay and subsistence, equipment and maintenance and transportation. Hence overall costs are estimated to be in the range of \$850 million to \$1.25 billion. These estimates assume that the bulk of the 15,000 man force would be U.S. military and represent the additional costs of deploying and operating these forces in Somalia. U.S. costs could be reduced by contributions from others.

Possible costs of a U.S. contribution to follow-on UN guard force are not estimated.

Option 1 could be financed within available resources and authorities, although consideration could be given at some point to seeking supplemental appropriations to replenish emergency accounts. Options 2 and 3 put the U.S. at risk for additional budget costs of \$1 billion or more depending on the size and duration of the operation and on the willingness of others to contribute. For these options, supplemental appropriations would likely be necessary either to provide additional resources or to allow appropriate reprogramming of available resources. For Option 3, a funding mechanism like that used for Operation Desert Storm might be considered. This would involve seeking appropriations from Congress to cover incremental U.S. costs and using existing Defense Cooperation Account to receive funding from other governments to offset some of these costs. Obviously, these cost estimates could be significantly understated if there is significant Somali resistance or if U.S. presence and assistance is required over a more extended period of time than now anticipated.
