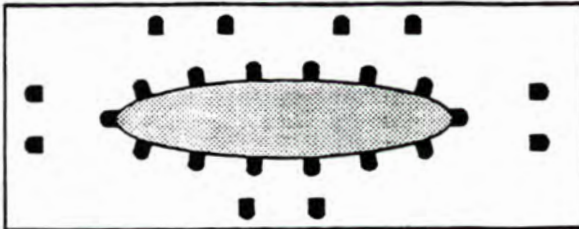

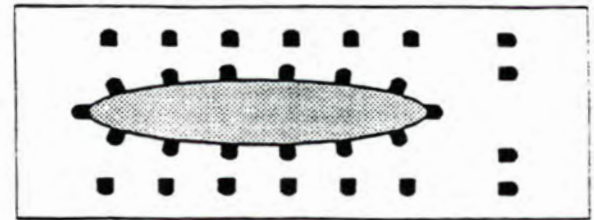

U-Shaped Conference Style :: Seating Capacity - 70 :: Podium



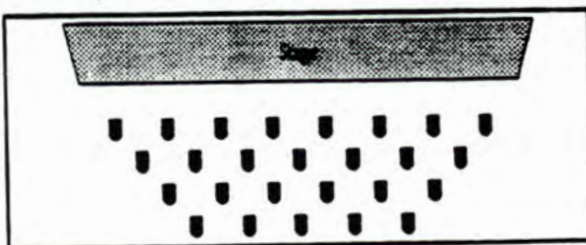

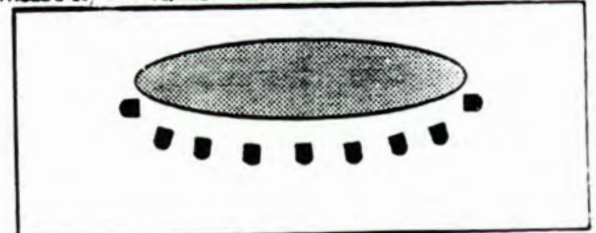

SUBJECT: MEETINGS TODAY WITH DOLE'S STAFF AND KASSEBAUM

DOLE

If the line in the campaign was, "The economy, Stupid!," then the line for this week must be, "How you gonna pay for it, Stupid?" To repeat the points Ray made returning from the meeting, it is better to have some argument, some statistics that show long term savings and reduction of entitlement dollars as a result of this initiative. Ray suggested that in the language of the legislation that there be a bias in the evaluation of projects to those which emphasized or targeted measureable results that translate to reduced entitlement expenditures: inoculated children, rebuilt homes, mentored and tutored children are much easier to quantify (as well as visualize in the mind of a pragmatic Republican senator, I might add), and can show longer term savings than cleaning a park.

I would like to add, consistent with the Kennedy staff emphasis yesterday, that more statistics clarifying the profound multiplier effect the 25,000 empowered service leaders will have on the service learning generation of K-12 will underscore our fiscal vision and responsibility. (You will remember the Youth Volunteer Corps as well as Kennedy figures show approximately 1.8 million 11-16 year olds can be engaged in these meaningful projects for every \$100 million, or about 1/16th the cost per participant, and at a much more impressionable age).

KASSEBAUM

The Senator's primary point was that coupling direct lending, income contingent payment, and service "will confuse national service" by putting too much in the reconciliation. At this point, she is more content to see the 200 institutions in the recent bill demonstrate what works, and what doesn't work. Loves "Teach For America."

(My message to her before you arrived was simply that 15 million at risk youth will not go away; that the intent is to do something to stimulate a profound new level of involvement, and that they must join with us to find the solution).
