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NAICU Public Policy Positions

1. NAICU endorses President Clinton's proposal to broaden higher education financing options to enable students to pay back their college loans through public and community service, or through income-contingent loans. But these alternatives to the current framework need to be part of an expanded national loan program, available to all students with multiple options for repayment. These include:
 - a. community service before, during, or after college
 - b. service after college in areas of critical national need, such as teaching, nursing, law enforcement, the military
 - c. income-contingent loans collected by the IRS, with the remaining principal written off after 25 years
 - d. conventional guaranteed student loans

Finally, interest on all student loans should be made deductible.

2. New loan alternatives must not be an excuse to shift more of the loan burden to students. Education is the best *investment* the individual and society can make. Society includes parents, federal and state governments, and colleges and universities.
3. As a result of declining federal and state funding, students at independent colleges and universities are receiving an ever-increasing amount of institutional financial assistance — more than \$4 billion this year alone in undergraduate and graduate student financial aid. Institutional aid, in turn, drives up tuition. Expanded eligibility for student aid in the 1992 Higher Education Act has resulted in \$1.3 billion more need for students at NAICU institutions alone. The escalating pressure for institutional aid cannot continue without serious harm.
4. Congress must appropriate funds to pay for the changes it mandated in the recently reauthorized Higher Education Act. Progress must be made toward full funding of Pell Grants and campus-based programs.
5. The ability of independent colleges and universities to raise private capital must be enhanced. The tax-exempt status of NAICU institutions must be maintained, in recognition of the important public purposes they serve. The full deductibility of charitable contributions must be restored if they are to continue to attract substantial private contributions.
6. Institutional grant funding should continue, particularly for developing institutions that serve a large number of minority students, as well as for improvements to science and laboratory facilities.
7. Government intervention and regulation must be minimized and academic and religious freedom protected, while insuring appropriate public accountability.

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
