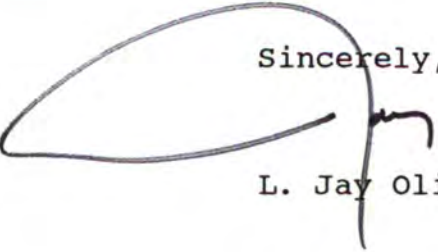
Dear Mr. Segal:
