Greenbelt National Park

In celebration of Earth Day 60 employees from the Environmental Protection Agency will volunteer to plant young trees at Greenbelt Park. The project will take place between the hours of 2pm and 4pm.

Garden Resources Of Washington – GROW

GROW is currently working with a seven member team from the DC Service Corps at a community garden on the corner of 14th and Earving. The garden is in its third year of existence. Thirty-two plots have been divided between families that live in nearby shelters and transitional housing developments. The families (known as the gardeners) use the plots to grow food. Some families are able survive on the food they grow on the plots, enabling them to live without the help of food stamps.
