Friday afternoon:

It is 10:15 am and I just got off the phone with you. Some of the info below was written before we spoke. I will try not to duplicate anything. I imagine that you and Eli covered some of these topics, I walked in while you were on the phone with Eli and I overheard him talking about the legislative strategy meeting.

Most importantly, we did have all five pages of the fax. Rick now has them and I faxed them to Gary. Catherine got all five pages and I will call Tom Ehrlich to see that he received them also.

I will start by answering your questions from yesterday's second fax and this mornings fax.

1) I did get your fax in time to go to the legislative strategy meeting yesterday (I found it very interesting). Participants were Eli, Jack, Tom Sander, Gene Sofer, Diana, Robert, Chris, John Gomperts, Marty Rogers, Shirley and Jack Sagawa (Jack was the star). I will try to explain the basics of the meeting, It did not always make sense to me so I hope this is somewhat understandable for you. Mark up is delayed until the 16th on the Senate side because Tom Sander was not ready and on the House side for three reasons: means testing, ACTION employees, civil service reform. I think you know about the circumstances for the first two reasons. Civil service became an issue yesterday morning in a meeting Jack and Eli had with Bill Clay. Clay is hesitant about changing the system.

There was debate about how best to get time on the floor on both sides. There was also talk about op ed's and lobbying to get more congressional support. Eli feels it is an insiders game now and that may be too much effort. Possibly more time should be devoted to direct contact to gain support. There was talk about asking the Governor's to help because we have given them so much with the bill. Also discussion on getting a big list of CEO sponsoring signatures. Final decision's were to have a lobby day before the mark up -- June 15th, trying to work on Post for a positive op ed and a lot of work to get the leadership in line so we can get time on the floor. The next meeting will be Monday at 5:00 in Ford's office. Should I go to that also?

2) Diana and Eli are pushing to get the American's for National Service photo on June 15th, before the mark-up. It was postponed from this Thursday.

3) Eli said his meeting with Catherine and Gary went well. Progress is being made and things are better now. He said that everyone has still not fallen in love with each other yet.

4) I scheduled lunch with Shirley for noon on the 17th.

5) I left a message with Ed Skloot, Sandy Horwitt now has your fax number, but he can probably wait until you return.

6) I let Marsha Adler know about your possibilities of speaking at her conference and I will work with her to ask Jack.

7) Ira Harkavy is out of town. I spoke with JoAnn Weeks and told her that you were unable to commit as of yet. She said that Nancy has definitely been invited and she thinks Peter Hocking has been invited, but she will double check.

8) On the NYC trip, no scheduling has been made. The sheet of paper you gave me had listed each sos site, Ray Chambers and some other possibilities. I was under the impression that it was ok to schedule the sos sites and Ray Chambers. With Kansas City, on the other hand, I was just to generate ideas for you to look at when you get back. Let me know if this is correct.

9) Eli met with Greg Johnson. He left the Phillips Brooks House folder in your box with a note that says he would like to discuss the meeting with you.

10) You received a fax from Vincent Marzullo of Action with a news article attached with the headline "\$5 million grant from Feinstein goes to Providence College." He has written on the cover sheet "[that] they are conducting a 2 day Pre-Service Orientation (PSO) for the VISTA Summer Associates at Providence College on June 9th and 10th. Mayor Cianci will administer the service oath on Thursday at 11:30 am. Ten summer associates will then be placed at Habitat for Humanity/Greater Providence to assist home-building efforts for the low-income."  
"Hope the assignment is going well."

11) Dan Ritchie Chancellor at the University of Denver called. He said Swanee Hunt referred him. He can wait to talk to you until you return.

1) Stationary: I went to Bethesda Engravers (on 17th). They cannot even print "The White House" on a business card without approval from Betty Ubbens in White House Administration. I called Betty to ask what we can do. She told me that Cheryl Mills must give her written approval to get cards made. I asked her about detailees, she said they can only use cards from their agencies. I then called another engraver to ask if they could print "The White House" on a business card. I am waiting to hear back from them. I think it is possible that Cheryl Mills would o.k. a card for you. This would be nice because you could get the emblem also. Which option would you like to pursue.

2) I asked Eli about the President's speech at Northeastern. Eli spoke with Dryer 5 days ago. Dryer said it was a good idea and we have heard nothing since.

3) I spoke to Peggy Arkin regarding the President's schedule on the 16th of July for the ECS National Forum. Right now the president is scheduled to take a vacation for that week. I told Peggy I would watch for changes in the schedule.

4) I am going to meet with Mina on Monday morning to discuss volunteer opportunities. I am still in the process of compiling the DC wide list of service sites. Tom Flemming will fax information about the older american programs in DC to me in the next couple of days.

5) Staff Meeting: Direct Lending made it out of committee yesterday with a vote of 15-2. The only two voting against were Wellstone and Harkin because they thought the 50% compromise went too far. Because it was passed in the House with the reconciliation package it will now be settled in conference. This was perceived as good news in staff meeting. Article on the front page of the NY Times.

Eli and Jack met with Ford and Clay yesterday. Eli feels that the means testing issue will probably not be a problem, no pure amendment would pass. He is not entirely satisfied with the two divisions of the corporation. The ACTION employees will probably be brought over as civil service without as much flexibility as we would like. Eli is comfortable with the investment division. Bisera will probably be part of the bill. Overall, the House looks good, Senate is not finished yet.

6) David and I will start to schedule NYCVC, ACTION and VISTA sites for the NYC/Newark trip, leaving holes for the SOS sites. Phil thinks the SOS directors will have no problem with flexibility in scheduling after the training week. The Oliva/Tisch meeting has not been scheduled. I do not know who requested it, Karen knows nothing about it, should I ask Eli?

7) In the mail you received a resume and cover letter from Kathy Connolly and cc of a letter to Keith Morton from Tina Cheplick, the SOS training team manager. The letter to Keith Morton said "I am sorry to learn that you will not be able to participate as a group leader due to a schedule conflict with Campus Compact activities."
