Dear Father Murphy:

Thank you for writing to me about improving the teaching profession. I appreciate you taking time to contact me.

I wholeheartedly agree with you on the importance of good teachers in a good education. Without the best teachers, we simply cannot have the best schools. In improving our educational system, the first item on the agenda must be to enhance the status of teachers. We must recognize that top-notch education can only be achieved when we have top-notch professional educators standing at the chalkboards. For your information, I have enclosed a copy of my speech on education, which includes proposals for improving the teaching profession.

Last year, I was a cosponsor of the National Teacher Act, which included provisions similar to your idea of an ROTC-type program to recruit college students to be teachers. Among other things, the National Teacher Act would have established a Teachers Corps, in which college students would receive scholarships in exchange for later teaching the disabled or those with limited English proficiency. The bill also would have forgiven Stafford Loans (formerly Guaranteed Student Loans) for those who taught in areas with teacher shortages or who taught subjects that had a shortage of teachers. I have also enclosed a summary of this legislation. Unfortunately, the full Senate did not take action on the bill before the end of the 101st Congress.

Thank you again for writing to me. Please feel free to do so again at any time.
