Dear Mr. Segal:

May I extend my congratulations on your appointment as the Director of the President's Office of National Service. I applaud your efforts to address a critical need and wish you success in the important endeavors of your office.

I read with great interest recent articles in the Washington Post (February 4 and 8, 1993), The Chronicle of Philanthropy (December 15, 1992, and January 26, 1993), the editorial pages of the New York Times (February 28, 1993), and accounts of President Clinton's recent speech concerning the national service initiative. Similarly, I reviewed the written testimony of the State Bar of California, recently presented to the President's Commission on National and Community Service. The Legal Services Corporation (LSC or Corporation) is enthusiastic about developments in national service, particularly as they may affect attorneys in public service who carry out the Corporation's mandate to provide civil legal services to the poor.

LSC is a private nonprofit corporation, created by act of Congress in 1974. Recognizing a need to provide equal access to justice, the Congress created the Corporation "for the purpose of providing financial support for legal assistance in noncriminal proceedings or matters to persons financially unable to afford legal assistance." With this mandate in mind, I believe that an opportunity exists for LSC to support the development and promotion of a Loan Repayment Assistance Program (LRAP) as part of the national service initiative.

The Corporation has been actively pursuing loan repayment assistance as a possible remedy to recruitment and retention challenges facing the 321 programs that we fund across the nation. Many new attorneys are financially unable to make a long term commitment to providing legal assistance to the poor through our field programs due to the combined effect of low wages and staggering school loans. Furthermore, the 1990 Census reported a significant increase in the poverty population in this country, while many programs have experienced staff attrition and reductions in total funding. We believe an LRAP holds a key to attracting -- and perhaps retaining -- law school graduates interested in public service careers.

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LSC is ideally suited to assist your office in the loan repayment assistance area, particularly with respect to some of the concerns noted by your office in recent news accounts. For example, LSC may be in a unique position to leverage available funds for a loan repayment assistance initiative, because LSC programs would not require stipends or additional federal support for existing salaried positions. Job opportunities available through LSC programs would be real jobs, benefitting the lives of thousands of poor individuals. A pilot project could be conducted within the framework of your office's need to start small in view of current budgetary realities.

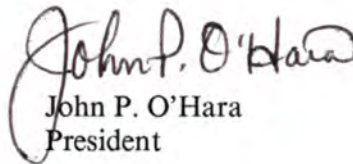
An LSC pilot project could accomplish the following objectives: 1) determine the advantages and disadvantages of loan assistance programs tied to national service requirements, on a local level; 2) develop a practical model, including training, based on real working experiences; and 3) measure the costs of such programs. The LSC Board of Directors has already proclaimed its support of such a pilot project and is attempting to secure funding for the idea through reprogramming of funds already appropriated for the current fiscal year.

The Office of National Service and the Legal Services Corporation, in collaboration, can create a beneficial project by making optimal use of federal funds through the use of an existing network of federally supported entities, covering every county in the nation as well as the U.S. territories and the District of Columbia.

In closing, I agree that education and public service dollars are dollars well spent and look forward to further developments in the area of national service. I would be happy to meet with you to discuss ways in which current LSC funds may be used to support a pilot project.

I am writing on behalf of the McDonough County United Way Board of Directors to introduce to you a recent innovation within our United Way which seems to closely parallel the thrust of the youth-service program proposed by you and President Clinton.

Effective with the year 1992, a donation was made to the McDonough County United Way by an individual (H. D. Leighty, Chairman of the Board, Engineered Products Co., Waterloo, Iowa) who has known a successful career but has remembered his "roots"--which were in McDonough County. He was inspired by, and attributes his success in life, to a woman who resided in our County, Sadie Moon, who took time from her busy life to be of personal help to him and others. He, therefore, made his donation in her name and the fund was thus titled the "Mother Moon Scholarship Fund". The "Mother Moon Scholarship Fund" is for the specific purpose of providing scholarships for education after high school for young people who have learned and practiced the value of service to others--who have taken time from their full schedule as a high school student to share joy and assistance with others in the community. The fund requires some matching community dollars. Additional information about the "Mother Moon Scholarship Fund" is enclosed for your review and consideration.

It occurs to us in McDonough County, after reading in the January 26, 1993, issue of The Chronicle of Philanthropy about your program's emphasis on, and challenge to, young people to "care for one another" that a program similar to the one we have implemented in our County (because we know that every community has a "Mother Moon") could certainly have merit on a national level. We encourage your interest in our program and would be pleased if you would be interested in publicizing and utilizing the design of the "Mother Moon" scholarship nationwide. It provides an example which organizations and charities could utilize in identifying and encouraging young people in their communities to experience the value of serving others.

thanking him for his challenge to service. Tell the President about your program sharing with him that you are carrying out his mandate to service. Remind the President that any incentive to service being offered by his administration, for example, vouchers, stipends, loan deferment/cancellation, etc. should also be made available to volunteers with tax exempt organizations affiliated with religious institutions as long as their service honors the Church-State limitations found in the Higher Education Act and the National Community Service Act.

Share with the President that this is already in place through the Higher Education Act of 1980 which included a provision on deferment for our groups. Two years ago in the National and Community Service Act we were once again included. This is an established concept but one which must be kept in effect. The same applies to any grants to an organization that sponsors volunteers. Indicate that you are a member of ILLVIM and that we have been in contact with him. A similar letter should be written today to the following persons:

RESULTS OF THE SURVEY: "THOUGHTS ON A GUIDEBOOK FOR PROSPECTIVE VOLUNTEERS"

Thank you to the 32 readers who took the time to fill out a book survey enclosed in this newsletter in October. The book has a working title of: "Guidebook for Prospective Volunteers and Lay Missionaries." Briefly, the book would include practical information about what to expect in a lay volunteer term of service from start to finish. It would not be a listing of organizations and their descriptions since "The Response" and "Connections" already provide that.

Here are the results of the book survey:

Is a guidebook for lay volunteers needed?

Yes: 2269%
No: 3 9%
Maybe: 618%

If a guidebook for lay volunteers is needed, what are the most important topics to address in such a book?

Responses varied in this section. About nine people simply endorsed the proposed outline. The remaining responses seemed to center on a couple of themes:

1.) As directors of organizations, many respondents want a book they can use in orientation programs. That is, a book that will explain some key parts of the term of service--living in an intentional community, living simply, and how to cope when the term of service ends. These suggestions easily fit into the outline I've proposed.

Many people also want the book to address re-entry, or transition into a non-volunteer setting.

2.) Organization directors seem to need a resource that will be realistic about what to expect during a term of service. Many people (in this survey and in conversations I've had) have said that a very common problem is that volunteers are so idealistic, they often become disillusioned a few months into the experience.

Practically speaking, would respondents actually buy a "Guidebook for Prospective Volunteers and Lay Missionaries"?

Yes:	17....53%	(Many did not answer this question.)
No:	6....18%	
Maybe:	3.... 1%	

Most favored paying between \$5 and \$10 for a paperback.

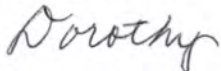

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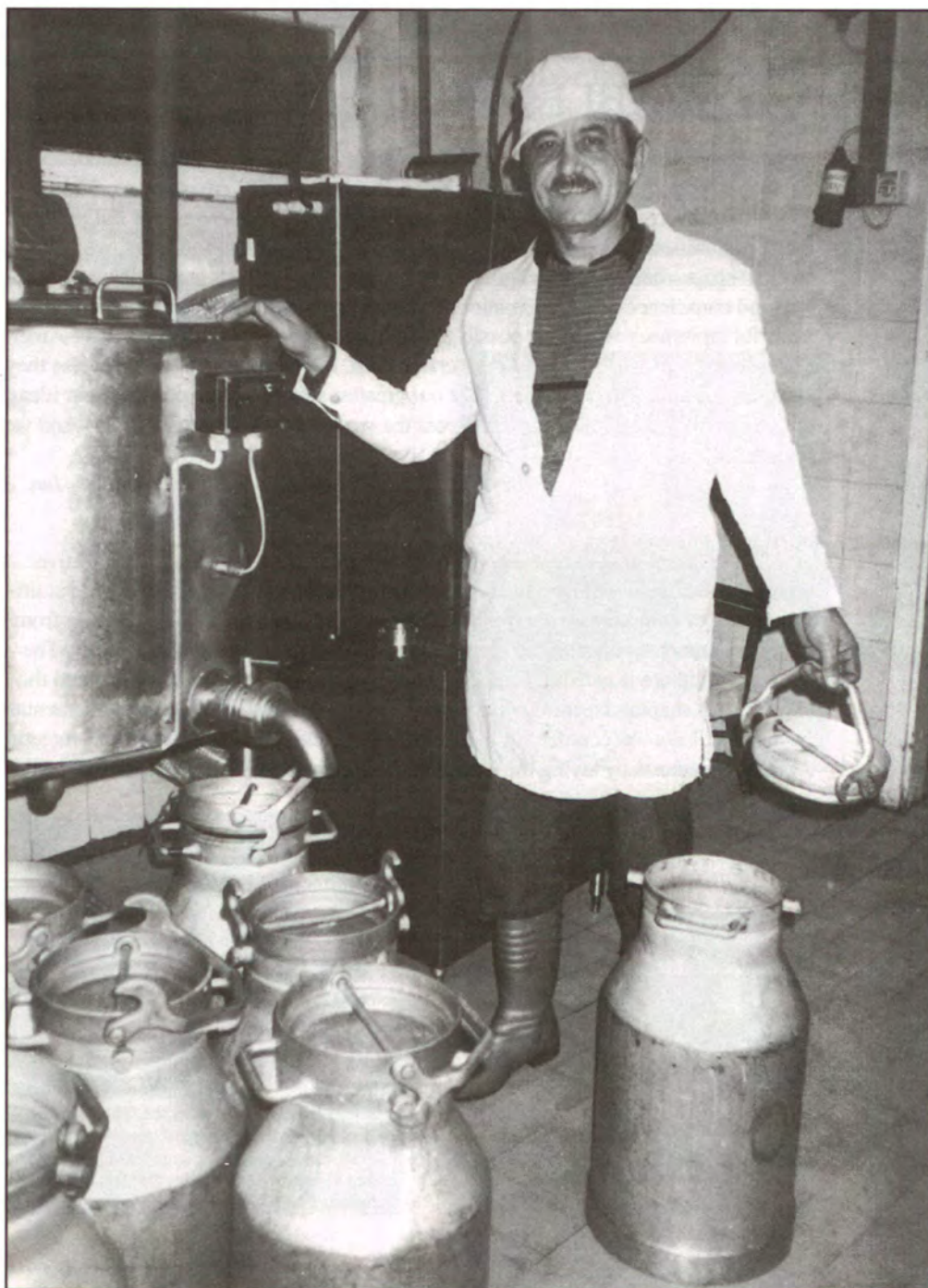
