I have just read of your appointment to head the Office of National Service, and of your interest in developing a youth service program to be operated in conjunction with nonprofit youth development organizations.

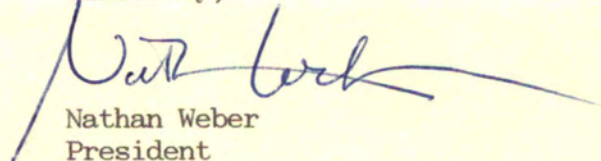
