Dee DeFiori called asking about the terminated AmeriCorps term of member **Galen Weins**. Dee stated she and others had questions about why this person would terminate for cause with only 200 or so hours remaining.

I explained to Dee that Mr. Weins resigned to take a job. He had neither the desire to further his education nor the need to pay off previous student loan obligations. We counseled with him and encouraged him to continue, but the job was too much of a lure. We incidentally had two other members resign to take similar jobs with the U.S. Department of the Army as civilians.

Consideration should be given to amending the AmeriCorps program authorizing legislation to prohibit federal or state agencies from hiring AmeriCorps members before they complete their term. Nearly all of our member resignations have been to take jobs with state or federal agencies.

The other side of the coin is that the program, in addition to providing national community service, also helps prepare the members to move into their communities to become responsible citizens. While we are meeting these broad objectives for the most part, we need to figure out how to keep our members through their completed terms. In most cases, we are succeeding even when they do not complete their terms.

All of our members who resigned have done so for the same reason, a job has become available and they do not have enough incentive to stay with the AmeriCorps program. All but one of these members have done a good job and have provided good service to their communities. The one exception was member Jennifer Weaver who abandoned her position. We were unable to contact her, therefore, she was terminated with cause.

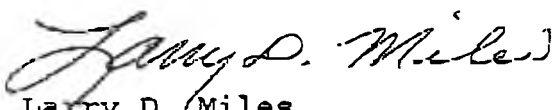

In response to the request for information regarding member enrollment forms, attached is a copy of the corrected database sheet for Louisiana. Angela Norsworthy is listed as not being enrolled in the trust. On June 28, 1995, a duplicate enrollment form was mailed to your office. Attached is a copy of that form. All members except Robin Torrence have completed their service, and Robin will complete her service on September 8, 1995.

Sobrena Lewis withdrew from the national service program because of personal and financial difficulties. I approved her request for early termination for compelling personal circumstances because I felt her situation warranted this determination. Sobrena was a very hard-working, dedicated member. She completed 902 hours of service and was able to accomplish her project objectives. Sobrena moved to Louisiana from Maryland to accept the AmeriCorps position with our agency. She had no family support available in Louisiana. After several stressful months of trying to make ends meet, Sobrena was faced with the reality that she could not survive on the stipend provided. Her only choice was to return home to Maryland. We have attempted to place Sobrena in other ongoing AmeriCorps programs in Maryland/Virginia/Washington DC in order to complete her term of service, but we have been unsuccessful.

Because of Sobrena's commitment to national service, I strongly recommend you consider awarding Sobrena a pro-rated education award. If this is not possible, please consider converting Sobrena to part-time member status, in order for her to receive a partial education award.

Education awards are only pro-rated if the AmeriCorps Member cannot complete the term of service for compelling personal reasons, which are defined in the operations manual. The reasons for her leaving the AmeriCorps program do not fit with the definition established by the Corporation for National and Community Service and USDA. We cannot authorize Ms. Lewis to receive a pro-rated education award.

AmeriCorps Members must complete their year of community service (a minimum of 1700 hours) in a 9-12 month period. In this situation it is possible to work towards a possible reassignment, so that Ms. Lewis can finish her community service with the AmeriCorps program in Maryland. This is to inform you of my withdrawal from the USDA/AmeriCorps program. Tomorrow, June 2, 1995 will be my last day in the AmeriCorps position at Twin Valley RC&D in Natchitoches, Louisiana. I have decided to return home to Maryland due to financial burdens and the stress that accompanied those burdens.

Although I was aware of the \$12,000 living allowance when I accepted the position, I did not realize how difficult it would be to support myself on this amount. Considering essential expenses such as rent, groceries, and electricity, as well as other common expenses such as gasoline and telephone bills, I now see that it is virtually impossible to "live" on \$12,000 without another source of household income.

I deeply regret that I will not be able to complete my "season of service" through this program. I have enjoyed being part of the AmeriCorps team which I feel has been beneficial to both myself and rural America. I hope to continue to participate in various community service activities in the future.

In response to your request dated August 9, 1995, we are forwarding to you the following information:

- Iver McLeod, SSN# [REDACTED] left the AmeriCorps program on January 18, 1995 because he found a permanent position and his financial situation required that he be working fulltime for more pay.
- Karen Bert, SSN# [REDACTED] left the AmeriCorps program on June 23, 1995, because her husband took another job in Washington State that started July 1, 1995. Karen was seven months pregnant at the time and in order to finish her hours she would have had to stay until the end of July. This would have put her too close to her due date and she would be all alone in Maine. We contacted Washington State to see if they had any vacant AmeriCorps positions for Karen to fill. Unfortunately they didn't.
- Karen Mushrall, SSN# [REDACTED] terminated her participation in the AmeriCorps program August 4, 1995 due to family problems. Karen's young husband died unexpectedly in his sleep in late January 1995. Karen and her young children were in shock for quite some time. Karen finally came back to the program in late February/early March but has struggled to complete the hours required for the program. Karen's children continue to have problems and this is why she has terminated her participation. Also, she would have been unable to complete the 1700 hours by September 11, 1995.

Juniper resisted this, as she believes that being involved with this program has been important to her personal growth.

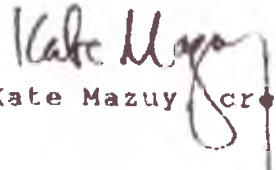

Dear Paula:

Your August 9, 1995 letter was mixed in with a pile of unrelated faxes so I did not find it until yesterday. I spoke with Dee the other day and she said to be sure to respond to the letter. Accordingly, the following is provided as documentation of the basis for termination of **Denise M. John** last fall.

AmeriCorps member, Denise M. John, was released for cause after working just 158.5 hours (9.3% of the required service hours). After slightly less than four weeks, Denise did not arrive for work. Later that morning she called to say she was not going to be in because of some personal business that needed attending. She did not come in the next day either. Attempts to contact her for the next two days were unsuccessful. Finally, we were able to leave a message with her mother (we think). Denise called back the next day to say she had been thinking long and hard about AmeriCorps and, while she enjoyed the work and the people involved, she did not feel she could handle the long drive (approximately 1.5 hrs.) to the field office throughout the winter. We had made arrangements to reimburse Denise for part of the mileage expense because of the extra long commute. She said the problem was the driving time involved and her concern about winter driving hazards, not the cost (though the reliability of her vehicle was also of concern).

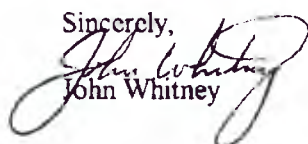
Denise said she realized that her quitting would be considered a "release for cause" because she failed to show up for work or to call in for four days. She said she wanted to be sure that she quit in time for us to be able to refill her position. AmeriCorps members have been in contact with Denise since her termination. She has said repeatedly that her brief experience was positive and that, had circumstances been different, she would like to have stayed on.

Since Denise did not complete at least 15% of the required service hours, I do not believe she would be eligible for a pro-rated education award under any circumstances.

Please call if you have any questions regarding Denise's termination or the classification as "for cause."

Accompanying this letter is a copy of the membership roster correcting the spelling of Lisa Matthies' name. By the way, Lisa was selected as an AmeriCorps "team leader." She'll be working in South Carolina (and eight or nine surrounding states)!
