LSC & OCP (Partners list attached) are interested in jointly participating in the USDA NCSC program. We propose a 50 participant program approximately 50% college students (including non-traditional learners) and 50% ANFC participants. Up to 20% of participants could come from the national pool.

Vermont will be implementing a seven year pilot welfare reform program July 1, 1994. Of the 700 families currently receiving ANFC in the Orleans Northern Essex Welfare District 60% (420) will be mandated to participate in work fare type programming. This will include an in depth family development plan which identifies family needs and barriers to employment, education and training needs etc. We propose a USDA-NCS project in which participants are formed into case management teams who will work with ANFC families to assure basic needs are met: food, shelter, child care, education, training and then assist families in achieving employment. Corollary USDA NCS would include:

- a team to do WIC intakes after hours and in remote sites to serve the working poor
- a team to work with the Micro Enterprise Program and the Community Development Corp. to promote self employment and job creation locally
- a team to work with in home elderly and handicapped, long term care providers to promote good nutrition
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- a team to work with expectant teen mothers around nutrition, basic needs and employment and training

All participants will receive basic citizenship, team building training and specific program training from relevant partners. Transportation for participants and clients will be provided under a contract with Rural Community Transportation.

This district currently has an 11.3% unemployment rate, the lowest per income in the state, the lowest educational and aspiration rate in the state.
