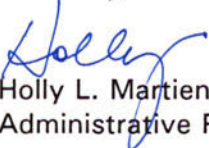

The Rural Development Team in Louisiana participated in a joint cluster meeting on Tuesday, November 28, 1995. During this meeting members and agency personnel discussed the duties of the project directors and AmeriCorps coordinator. Members were also advised of who to contact if problems or questions arise. Members were able to participate in a teleconference with Joel Berg, Director of National Service for the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and USDA/AmeriCorps members and supervisors in Oklahoma. During this teleconference, members were given an opportunity to introduce themselves and tell a little about their projects. Joel Berg provided information on AmeriCorps and was highly motivational in his presentation to the members.

Effective report writing training was conducted during this cluster meeting. Members were given an assignment to prepare a quarterly report with measurable results on the following situation:

Complete home repairs for elderly citizens in the of Metropolis.

Objective 1 Members will contact elderly citizens of Metropolis to assess home repair needs.

Objective 2 Members will survey availability of materials, suppliers, providers, and community action groups in Metropolis.

Objective 3 Members will coordinate repairs to at least 10 residences of elderly citizens of Metropolis.

Members were divided into four break-out groups and given one hour to complete their quarterly reports. All four groups reported outstanding success in achieving their objectives. Measurable, detailed results were reported, and Metropolis was a better place because of AmeriCorps--and they did not have to call Superman! This was a very successful training exercise, and members have a clear understanding of how to report measurable results.

Attached is a listing of USDA/AmeriCorps clusters/members in Louisiana. Please review this listing to determine your cluster group. Also attached is a schedule of who will serve as cluster leader and cluster recorder December 1995 through September 1996 with a detailed description of cluster leader and cluster recorder duties. ***Review the description of cluster leader and cluster recorder duties. December cluster leaders should immediately begin scheduling their December cluster meeting and developing an agenda.***

Monthly cluster meetings are a REQUIREMENT of your USDA/AmeriCorps national service. You can make these meetings fun and informative by scheduling interesting guests as speakers or arranging to provide community service as a group during your cluster meeting (such as tree plantings in a park or working at a community festival). Some of the meetings will involve training that is scheduled by an agency representative (first aid training, defensive driving training, etc), but most cluster meetings will be entirely organized by cluster leaders. Cluster meetings are an opportunity to share successes, discuss problems, brainstorm for ideas on how to accomplish difficult objectives, and report progress.

It is important that cluster recorders report activities of cluster meetings and any progress reported in the cluster meeting minutes. These minutes will be shared with all USDA/AmeriCorps members in Louisiana and forwarded to agency personnel in Washington, DC.
