Dear Mr. President:

The Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, the Federal agency that provides a forum for influencing Federal policy and programs as they affect historic preservation nationwide, is delighted to submit to you a copy of our *Report to the President and Congress 1996-1997*. Provided pursuant to Section 202(b) of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, the report describes the Council's work to advance its mission, "to promote the protection and enhancement of our Nation's historic resources."

Report 1996-1997 examines the agency's broad statutory charge in the context of four program areas—Policy Development and Program Coordination; Federal Agency Historic Preservation Program Improvement; Education, Training, and Public Awareness; and Management of the Section 106 Review Process. This review process, unique in Federal Government, ensures that when a Federal activity adversely affects a historic property, the responsible agency will consider the project's impacts and attempt to minimize harm.

The report chronicles the Council's reauthorization by Congress; highlights policy initiatives; and covers cooperative efforts between the Council and other agencies. It discusses the development of the Council's Web site and its ongoing effort to revise its regulations that govern the Section 106 review process. Finally, *Report 1996-1997* provides a list of noteworthy Section 106 review cases.
