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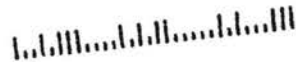

Dear Mr. President:

It has been my privilege to serve your administration as Under Secretary for Health in the Department of Veterans Affairs for nearly five years. When I took office in October 1994, your charge to me was to reengineer the veterans health care system so that it could effectively function in the 21st century. I am proud to say that much has been achieved toward this end. Indeed, without reservation, I can tell you that no other health care system in the United States has changed as rapidly or as dramatically as has the veterans health care system since we initiated the Prescription for Change in 1995.

Over the past several years, we have changed the basic operating and management structure of the Veterans Health Administration. We have found new ways to help fund medical care programs, and we have designed and implemented a new way of equitably allocating appropriated funds that has also introduced unprecedented financial discipline to the system. We have eliminated conflicting and confusing rules governing eligibility for care, and ensured that treatment is provided in the most appropriate setting. Likewise, we have markedly expanded access to care, substantially increased the number of veterans treated, significantly improved service satisfaction and fundamentally changed the culture of VA health care. We also have unequivocally improved the quality of VA health care, and VA's initiatives in quality management and patient safety, end of life care, hepatitis C, pain management, and the integration of mental and physical health, among others, are widely viewed as leading the health care industry in these areas. Indeed, the accomplishments of the "new VA" are many, and it should be of more than academic interest that on standard quality and performance indicators the "new VA" outperforms Medicare across the board, providing a similar scope of benefits at about half the per capita cost that Medicare pays.

Please know that while today's VA health care system is unquestionably much improved from the past, and the Veterans Health Administration is a much stronger organization than before, the changes that I have introduced into VA health care over the past several years have not been without controversy or without their critics. While I suppose that such is inherent to effecting the type of far-reaching change that we have pursued,

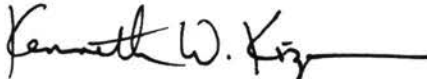

it has, nonetheless, become clear that I will not be confirmed for a second term before my present term of office expires. After the prolonged interval of uncertainty about my continued tenure with the Department last fall between the end of my first term and enactment of PL 105-368 (Section 907), which extended my term until June 30, 1999, I promised both my family and myself that I would not repeat that scenario. Thus, I ask that you now withdraw my nomination for a second term, which you sent to the Senate on January 6, 1999. I will not be seeking to stay on as Under Secretary for Health after my term expires tomorrow.

While much has been done to transform the veterans health care system over the past several years, it remains a work in progress. A number of key issues will demand very close management attention in the upcoming months. In this regard, if desired, I would be willing to stay on in some mutually agreeable capacity for a short period of time to assist with an orderly transition.

Again, thank you for the opportunity to serve in your Administration, and as an orphan of a deceased veteran I thank you for the opportunity to give something back to the Department of Veterans Affairs for some of the benefit I received from it as a child and student.

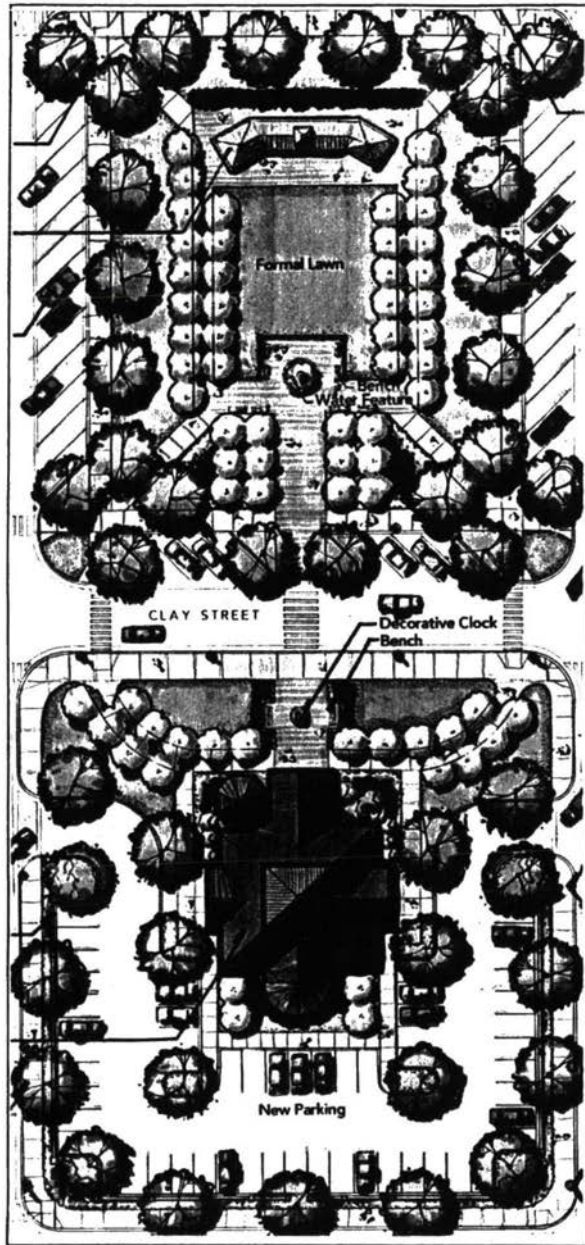
