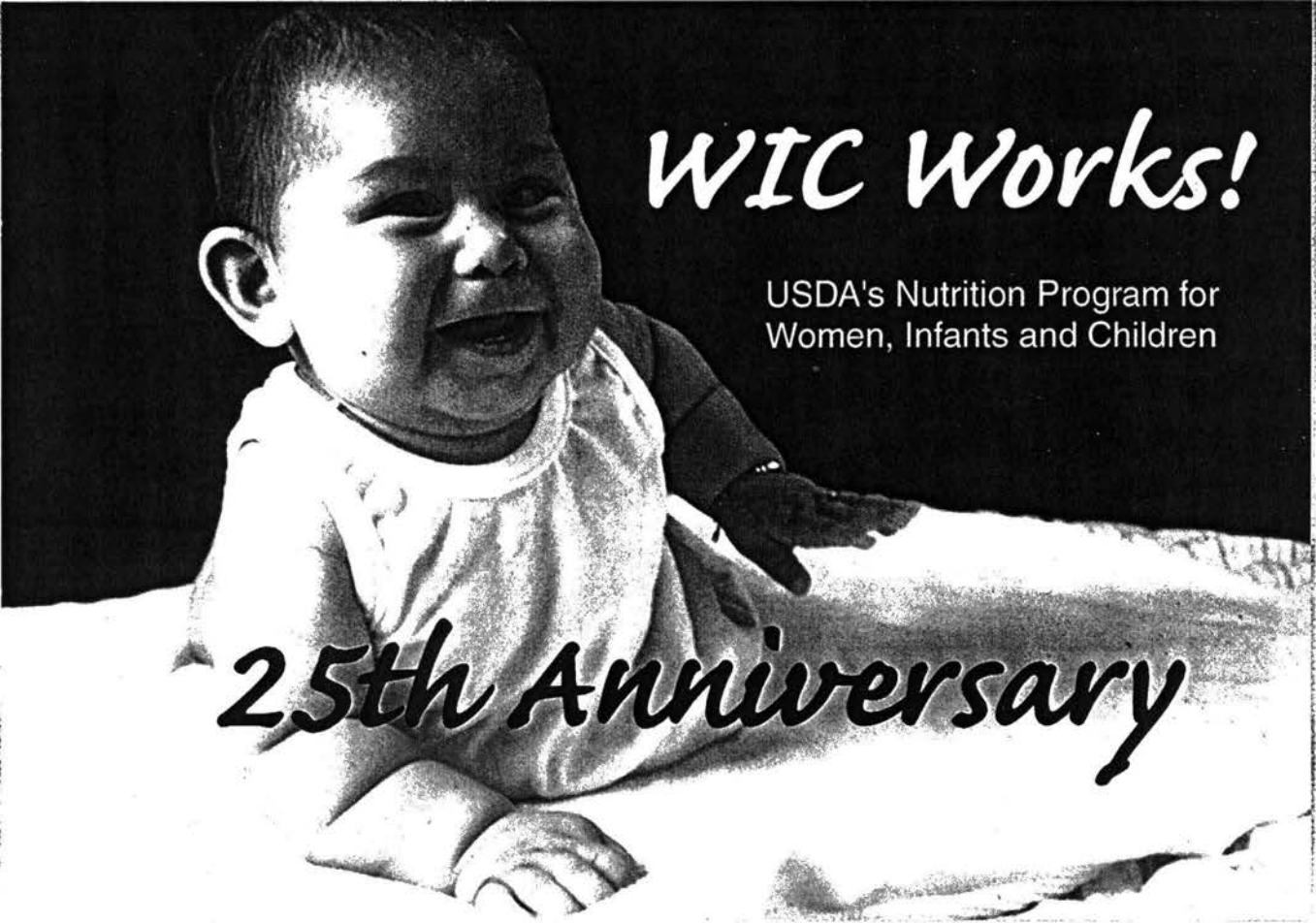

Dear Mr. President:

On behalf of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in the United States and Canada, I want to express deep appreciation for having granted executive clemency to the Puerto Ricans that were imprisoned for almost 20 years. We recognize the political risk that you took with this decision in order to do what was right and just. As I wrote to you some weeks ago, when you first offered the clemency, we thoroughly agree with you and all those Human Rights fighters, such as Archbishop Desmond Tutu and Coretta Scott King, in that these prisoners had received excessive and disproportionate sentences for the charges for which they were convicted. We are sure that these Puerto Ricans will be an asset to their community upon their release. They have publicly and privately stated their commitment to non-violence and to continue their goals to resolve the political status of Puerto Rico through democratic processes.

Unfortunately, we continue to be saddened by the fact that three of the Puerto Rican prisoners still face many years behind bars. Our joy will not be completed and our plea with you will not end until we see all of them free. We hope and pray that, before you leave office, you will also grant clemency to Carlos Alberto Torres, Oscar López Rivera and Juan Segarra Palmer.

Mr. President, our most heartfelt gratitude for granting these men and women the opportunity to be back with their own community. But remember, there are still three more waiting to be free.
