This Special Message contains 10 proposed rescissions of budgetary resources, totaling \$400.4 million, from funds available to the Department of Defense. Including this special message, funds proposed for rescission in FY 1997 now total \$1.4 billion.

Dear President Clinton:

Last week was the first anniversary of my husband's death, and I was lucky enough to be in Washington that day so that I could spend time with Lee Williams and David Lambert. I could not have managed without them last year and count them as dear friends.

I told Lee that life looks different from my new vantage point in East Hampton - not better or worse, but different - and I am enjoying the change. My house is surrounded by trees, and I can walk to the beach within five minutes. It is a beautiful peaceful retreat. I don't spend much time here, however. Even though I have never once sought the podium, I am asked more and more to speak and do so willingly because an understanding of Fulbright philosophy and education, both national public schooling and international exchange, are so essential to our health and future.

What has also become clear to me out here is that your re-election is essential to our health and future as well. Vital national issues such as the environment and pollution, population control, and the support and preservation of our culture are clearly in danger of distortion and neglect. The whole atmosphere needs the influence of gentler voices interested more in social cohesion, a genuine search for solutions through consensus and reason, a feeling of *inclusion* among all of us.

 If there is any way you think I might be of service, please count on me. I realize that I do not have long experience in campaigning, but I have a few skills which Lee can evaluate. Just let me know.

I did not realize your health was failing until I read where the spokesman for the marshal service announced you were in trouble.

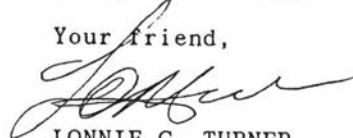
I enclose a copy of the article with the statement highlighted.

# U.S. marshal's position not likely to be filled soon

The death of the top marshal in the Western District of Arkansas has left a void not likely to be filled soon, according to the United States Marshal Service.

Hugh Black, 70, died Feb. 9 at his home in Bentonville after a lengthy battle with congenitive heart problems. Black was appointed to the top marshal's post in the Western District of Arkansas two years ago by President Bill Clinton. He was the first U.S. marshal to be sworn in during

the Clinton administration.

Chief Deputy Mike Blevins will take Black's post until someone is appointed by the president, according to David Turner, spokesperson for the Marshals Service in the nation's capitol.

Turner said the next appointee will have to undergo a lengthy process that may outlast the president. Nominations are usually taken from U.S. senators, run through the White House personnel office and then are forwarded to the president. After that, they go to the Senate for confirmation, he said.

"It's a fairly lengthy process. There's always a backlog up there on the Hill. Marshal Black was unusual in that his (appointment) went very fast because of his association with the administration. They were familiar with his fine work," Turner explained.

A World War II Navy veteran, Black served as a deputy U.S. marshal for two decades in Fort Smith.

Before that, he was the Benton County sheriff and chief of police in Bentonville.

Blevins could not be reached for comment Monday.
