I served honorably as a P38 Fighter Pilot in WWII and in the Korean War with a secret clearance in the Korean War. I received my Real Estate Broker and my Business Opportunity Broker licenses in 1946 and continued service to the real estate industry until 9/13/72. At that time my license was revoked after 21 years through a conspiracy. The California Division of Real Estate has refused to investigate the *conspirators* which are Marian O. Martin, Betty Baer and The First American Title Company. My record as a man serving this country is unblemished. I am a life member of the Disabled American Veterans. We do wonderful things to help our veterans. Last year at the College of San Mateo, I completed the following courses: Real Estate Principles, Real Estate Evaluation, Legal Aspects, Real Estate Finance 1 with a GPA of 3.25.

You know President Clinton, in the Airforce we have a saying, "the difficult we accomplish at once and the impossible takes just a little bit longer".

The Revocation of my broker's license was illegal because the Department of Real Estate waited 5 years after the offense to start the prosecution. For a government agency to admit they are wrong is like saying, "the sun will not rise tomorrow morning".

I was wondering why I was called in for a hearing in the first place. Both women had known me for many years (20 years). I have presented this situation to 3 commissioners down the line. Dear President Clinton:

First, let me, belatedly, thank you for your letter on Product Liability Reform. Though we obviously differ on a number of points, I think that probably substantial legislation could be passed in the next Congress. It is my understanding that the Trial Lawyers themselves may be amenable to discussions. As you know, Bob Barrie and I met at some length with Bruce Lindsey on the subject before your veto, and, of course, worked closely with Senator Rockefeller and others in securing the necessary cloture votes.

On another subject, as somewhat of a consolation prize, I would like to invite you to speak at the first Corporate Counsel Institute at Georgetown Law Center in Washington, DC, to be held in March of 1997. I have been privileged to act as the chair of a group of some 25 General Counsel in organizing and forming the program, which I believe will be the first of its kind, and certainly the first for Georgetown.

Since the program will be held at the Law Center, at the foot of Capitol Hill, it would allow for easy access and could be the forum for a major talk on law related subjects, of which there will be myriad facing the country in the next years.
