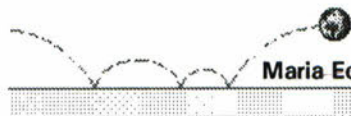

Subject: Outreach Plan for Global Climate Change

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Below is brief outline of a proposed outreach plan that OPL would undertake with assistance from other offices. We developed this plan in consultation with Intergovernmental and Legislative Affairs.

We propose organizing a series of half-day briefings at the White House with senior White House staff and Cabinet members doing the briefing. The purpose of the briefing is to educate a broad range of opinion leaders. The briefings could be organized around specific interests or occupations, such as the following:

Key elected state and local officials with known environmental interests,
Regional editorial page writers and/or environmental reporters (all media),
Health care associations and advocacy groups,
Insurance industry representatives,
Foreign Policy think tank/academicians/writers and
Religious leaders.

Our plan would be to invite individuals from all parts of the country and from a broad cross-section of influence. For example, while we will be hearing directly from the CEO's of major insurance companies, we should target regional and state mid-level representatives to educate a much larger group of the insurance community.

These briefings could be scheduled one a week beginning the week of September 8 and continuing after the White House Conference on Climate Change on October 6. We would also work closely with Natalie Wymer to maximize the communications and message potential of these briefings

As we discussed, OPL will take the lead in organizing these briefings in coordination with other offices. We will have an organizational meeting to set timelines and make assignments this week before everybody takes off for vacation.

White House Climate Change Outreach Plan

Background:

- The President's meeting with the 10 CEO's of "Fortune 500" companies created a new spark of interest in industry toward becoming part of the solution to climate change -- so long as the Administration's proposed policy framework is achieved (combining binding emissions budgets with reasonable timing, emissions trading and joint implementation).
- One CEO proposed an intriguing possibility: in exchange for a "reasonable target" (such as 2010 - 2020), industry would step forward to enter voluntary agreements "with real teeth" in the period leading up to the binding regime.
- Other CEO's stressed the importance of a stronger public-private commitment to an effort to research, develop and deploy climate-friendly technologies.

Objectives:

- Build positive momentum from CEO meeting.
- Develop enhanced voluntary CEO commitments that could be unveiled at October White House Conference.
- Follow-up on other suggestions from CEO meeting through more focused, sectorally-focused discussions on how best to deliver:
 - technology strategies and other market-based domestic policies;
 - international policy framework (binding emissions budget alternatives, JI, international emissions trading, developing country commitments);
- Begin to create the coalition of supporters for an American position for Kyoto.

1. The Electric Power Sector

Desired Outcome: Companies could agree to rally other electric utilities for new, improved commitments for the October conference. The President could assure credit for early action. In addition, these companies could be expected to support and participate in a "climate technology for the future" drive. Later, when the President reinforces his commitment to U.S. policy framework and announces the terms of the "realistic, achievable and binding target," these commitments (and tonnes pledged) would serve as a show of force in American resolve to combat climate change.

- The President will meet in early October with CEO's of the **"Big 3" automobile manufacturers**.
- Secretary of Transportation Slater, NASA Administrator Goldin and Undersecretary of State Wirth or Eisenstadt could be helpful in meeting in September with CEO's of leading **airlines** (Northwest, American, United, Delta, etc.) and **aircraft manufacturers** (Boeing) on some specific proposals that could garner their support (relating to international standards and enhanced air traffic control proposals).
- Secretary Daley and Administrator Browner could be helpful in meeting with the **electronics and telecommunications industries** (Intel, Microsoft, AT&T, US West, Ameritech, that use modest amounts of CFC substitutes and are participating now in voluntary efforts to reduce. They could possibly expand their commitments to continually improve post 2000.
