Dietrich Bonhoeffer: A Life in Pictures

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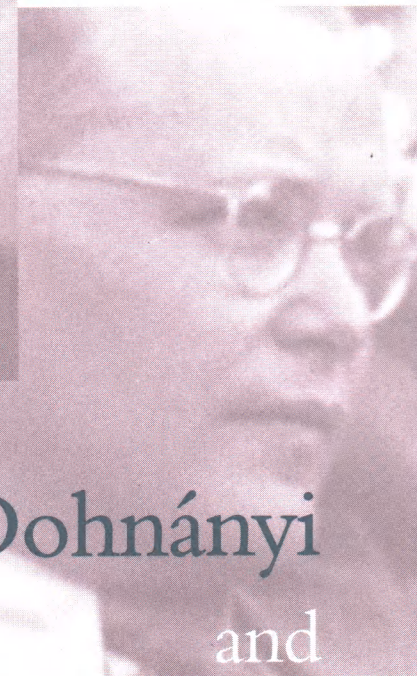
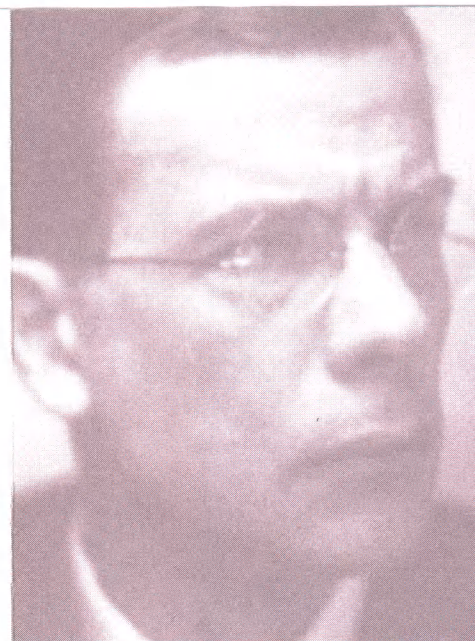
The United States Holocaust Memorial Museum is America's national institution for the documentation, study, and interpretation of Holocaust history, and serves as this country's memorial to the millions of people murdered during the Holocaust.

The Holocaust was the state-sponsored, systematic persecution and annihilation of European Jewry by Nazi Germany and its collaborators between 1933 and 1945. Jews were the primary victims — six million were murdered. The Roma and Sinti, people with disabilities and Poles were also targeted for destruction or decimation for racial, ethnic or national reasons. Millions more — including homosexuals, Jehovah's Witnesses, Soviet prisoners of war and political dissidents — also suffered grievous oppression and death under Nazi tyranny.

The Museum's primary mission is to advance and disseminate knowledge about this unprecedented tragedy, to preserve the memory of those who suffered, and to encourage its visitors to reflect upon the moral and spiritual questions raised by the events of the Holocaust, as well as their own responsibilities as citizens of a democracy.

Members of two remarkable families related by marriage, *Hans von Dohnányi* and *Dietrich Bonhoeffer* were also linked by their resistance to the Nazi regime.

Reared in Germany, Hans von Dohnányi was the son of the noted Hungarian composer Ernst von Dohnányi. He became a leading jurist and legal scholar, rising to a senior position within the Ministry of Justice in the Weimar Republic. In the late 1930s he was assigned to the *Abwehr* (military intelligence), where he compiled a secret record of Nazi crimes. He was a central figure in the March 1943 assassination attempt on Adolf Hitler, personally delivering the explosives that were placed aboard Hitler's private plane. Hans von Dohnányi was subsequently arrested for his work with the resistance, including his involvement in "Operation 7," the escape from Germany of 14 persons — Jews and others of Jewish ancestry — to Switzerland. He was executed in the Sachsenhausen concentration camp on April 9, 1945.

Hanged in the Flossenburg concentration camp that same day, his brother-in-law, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, was from a family also known for its contributions to German culture, the professions and public service. Dietrich Bonhoeffer was one of the first Christian theologians to focus attention on Nazi attacks against the German Protestant Church. He became a leader of the anti-Nazi Confessing Church, heading an underground seminary until the Gestapo closed it in 1937. Although repudiating Nazism, Bonhoeffer also expressed the anti-Jewish bias of centuries-old Christian teaching. Eventually, his personal antipathy towards the Nazis resulted in his membership in the German resistance. Like Hans von Dohnányi, Bonhoeffer participated in, and was arrested and executed for, his work with the resistance, including "Operation 7." His writings, particularly *Letters & Papers from Prison*, have greatly influenced American and South African civil rights leaders.
