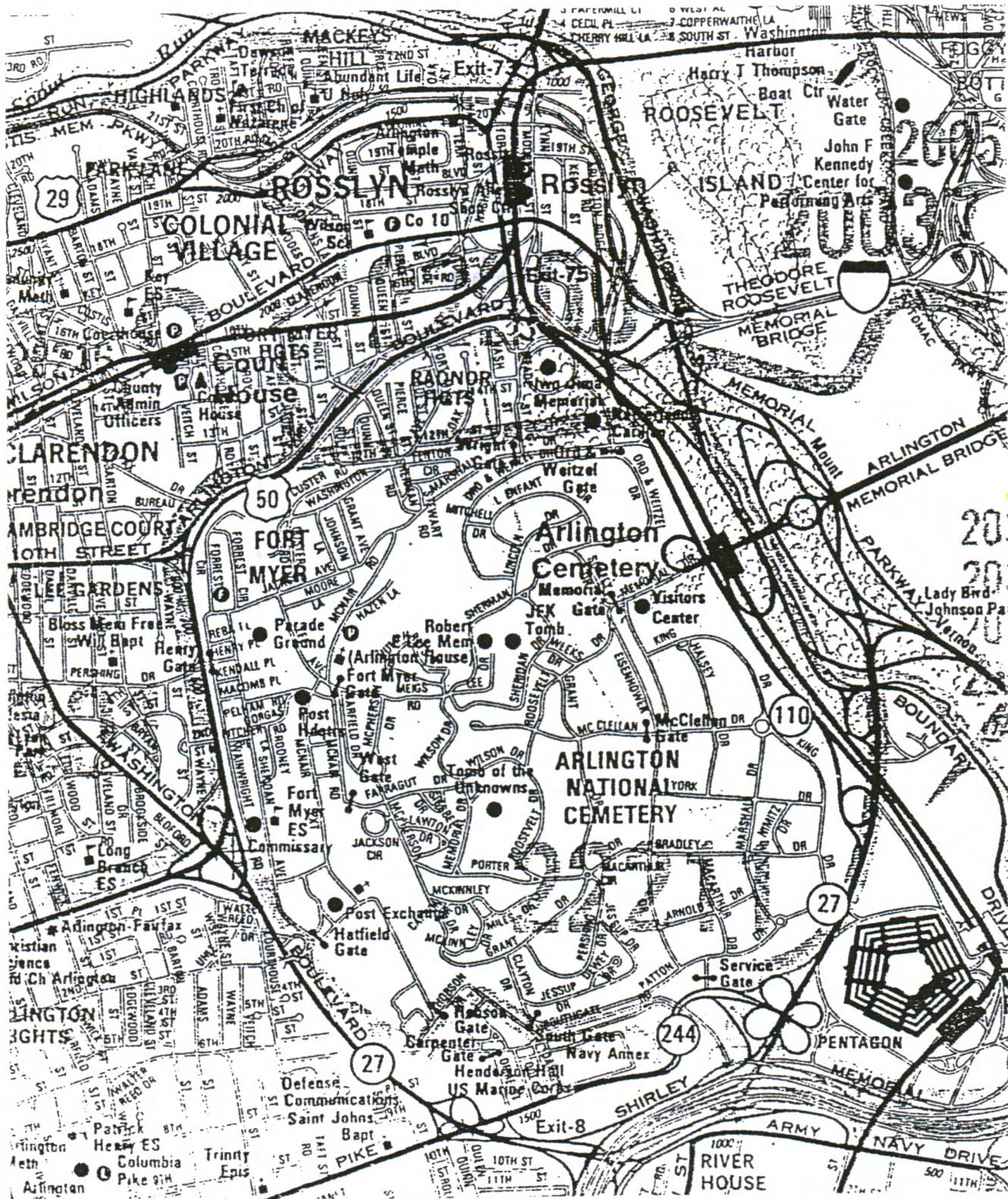
DIRECTIONS TO THE MARINE CORPS WAR MEMORIAL

From Virginia - Travel north on Shirley Highway, I-395, take exit for Memorial Bridge, follow signs for Rosslyn US 50 West, and take first Rosslyn exit. Turn left on Lynn Street, proceed to Marshal Drive, turn left on Marshal (away from Fort Myer Gate). Continue to signs for U.S. Marine Memorial/Netherlands Carillon, turn left, and proceed to parking area.

From Maryland - Travel south on 495, take the George Washington Memorial parkway (north) exit. Exit at Memorial Bridge, turn right at Memorial Drive, go around traffic circle at Columbia Plaza, and take exit for US 50 West and Rosslyn. Take first Rosslyn exit, turn left at Lynn Street, and proceed to Marshal Drive, turn left on Marshal (away from Fort Myer Gate). Continue to signs for U.S. Marine Memorial/Netherlands Carillon, turn left, and proceed to parking area.

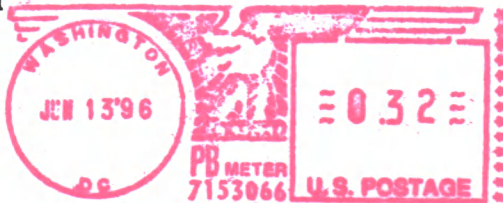
Inside Washington, DC - Go south on the 14th Street Bridge. Take first exit from bridge (Arlington Cemetery), follow signs for Rosslyn, Key Bridge, US 50 West, and take first exit from Rosslyn. Turn left on Lynn Street, proceed to Marshal Drive, and turn left on Marshal (away from Fort Myer Gate). Continue to signs for U.S. Marine Memorial/Netherlands Carillon, turn left, and proceed to parking area.

Metrorail. The Arlington National Cemetery station on the Blue line is a short walk from the Arlington National Cemetery Visitors Center. Marine Barracks provides a free shuttle bus service from the Visitors Center to the parade grounds from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., with return service from 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Metrorail runs until midnight on Tuesdays.

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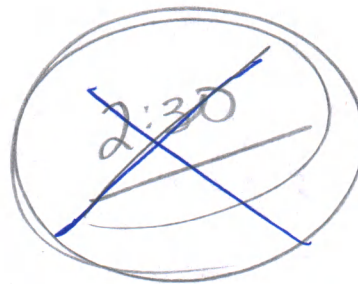
