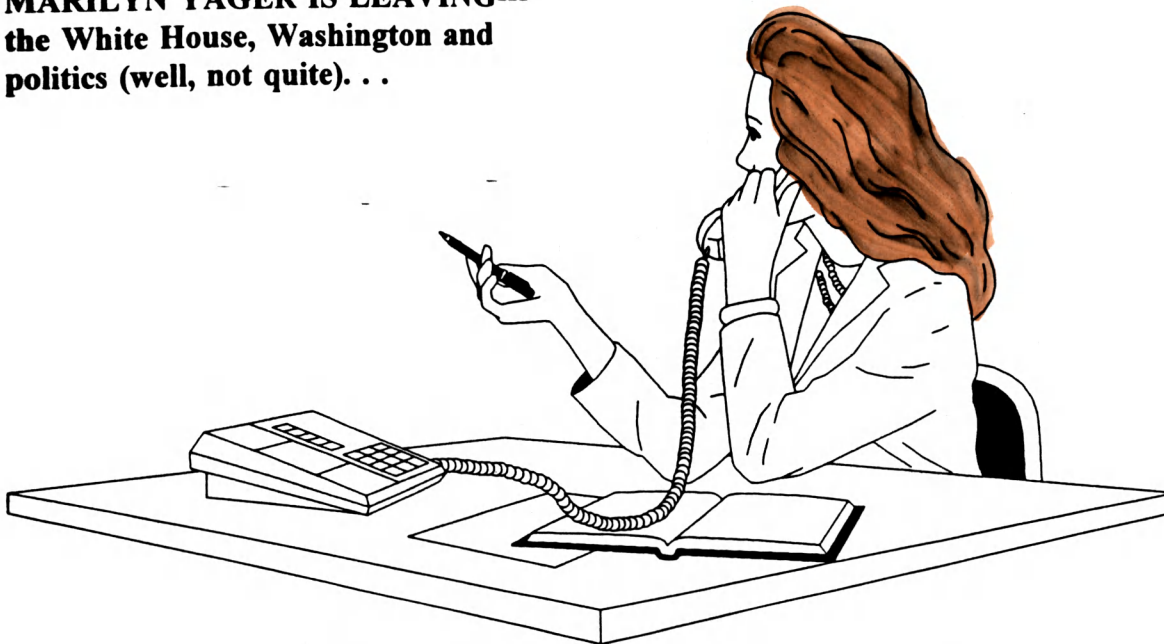

Interagency Security Classification Appeals Panel (ISCAP)
on July 25, 1996

What is the ISCAP? Under Executive Order 12958, "Classified National Security Information," the ISCAP serves as the appellate body to review decisions of agency heads concerning the continued classification of specific information or documents. The agency head may appeal an ISCAP decision to the President.

Who is the ISCAP? Representatives of six executive branch organizations make up the membership: NSC, State, Defense, Justice, CIA and the National Archives. The Justice member, Roslyn Mazer, was appointed as Chair by the President. As the Director of the Information Security Oversight Office (ISOO), I serve as ISCAP's Executive Secretary, and members of the ISOO staff serve as a staff for the ISCAP. The members or their alternates, several staff aides from the agencies, and several ISOO staff members will be the persons attending the July 25 meeting. Please refer to the attached list.

What do the Chair and I want Mr. Stern to address? We want Mr. Stern to emphasize the President's continued commitment to the principles of open government addressed in E.O. 12958 and other presidential issuances: i.e., to reduce classification and to increase declassification significantly, while safeguarding that information that clearly warrants the protection of classification. He should also address the critical role of the ISCAP to this commitment; i.e., through its decisions, the ISCAP will set the standards that will define the cutting edge of what should be classified and what should not be classified. To be successful, the ISCAP members must rise above the agency parochialism that so often dooms interagency groups to ineffectuality.
