No technological achievement of the Twentieth Century has had so profound an effect on humanity as powered flight. Yet most people have only the faintest notion about what keeps airplanes and orbiting satellites from falling out of the sky. Now, a new gallery at the National Air and Space Museum called HOW THINGS FLY will help demystify the subject. The goal of HOW THINGS FLY is to provide the Museum visitor with a genuine understanding of the basic principles of flight.



The gallery contains over 50 interactive devices, including a supersonic wind tunnel that visitors can manipulate. Also featured are a Cessna 150 that visitors can climb aboard, and a cross-section of a Boeing 757 fuselage that visitors can walk through.

HOW THINGS FLY is made possible through the generous funding of The Boeing Company and a grant from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, with additional support from the National Science Foundation, The Smithsonian Institution Special Exhibition Fund and The James Smithson Society.

The human element of the gallery will be the presence of the "Explainers," a group of enthusiastic high school and college students who will be on hand to present daily demonstrations on the forces of flight, assist visitors with the interactive devices, and answer questions. The "Explainers" Program is made possible through a generous gift from Cessna Aircraft Company.

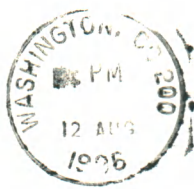
