FROM WASHINGTON, DC

Take Key Bridge to the George Washington Parkway (first right over the Key Bridge coming from M Street in Georgetown.) Follow the GW Parkway for about ten minutes. You'll come to the Capitol Beltway (495) and will run parallel to it very briefly to your left. Exit at Georgetown Pike - also called Route 193 - by bearing right. Turn right towards Great Falls. Continue on Georgetown Pike for about a mile (this is a country road.) You will pass Swinks Mill Road on your left. A sign saying "Potomac Overlook" will be up a little way on your right. Just past that, a few hundred yards on your right, is the turn to Tulip Hill. The sign will say Private Road and will be marked "7700 to 7726 Georgetown Pike". This road will be just before two yellow traffic signs. Drive up this road for about a third of a mile (you will be going towards the Potomac River.)

You will see two stone columns on either side of the road marked "Tulip Hill". Drive through, the house is up on your left, tan and white with black shutters.

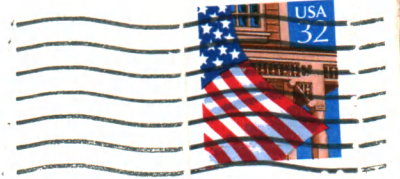

After an opportunity to meet one another and share in lunch, Rabbi Sid Schwarz led a study period on "Jewish Classical Views of Law and Government." It was a stimulating, exciting, and illuminating discussion to which everyone contributed. Bill Moyers, watch out!

The group was quite eager to meet again and to make our study group a monthly gathering. We hope to meet the first Friday of every month for lunch and study with a commitment to come promptly at 12 noon for lunch with study going until 1:45 p.m. That means that our next meeting will be on December 6th. DIRECTIONS

From Washington, D.C.:

Take Canal Road West, out of Georgetown, to the Clara Barton Parkway. Proceed on the Clara Barton heading Northwest and take it to the point it terminates, at MacArthur Boulevard. There is a spot near Glen Echo where the Clara Barton seems to exit to MacArthur, but stay in the left lane and bear left up a little incline and down around the road construction. Then remain on the Clara Barton, past the 495 Beltway, past the David Taylor Research Center, until it ends. Turn right onto MacArthur and go about 1/4 mile to your first left, Mountain Gate. At the top of the hill, take your first left, Eagle Ridge Drive. Proceed a few blocks to your first right, Eagle Ridge Court. We are # 6 on the left.

If you exit the Clara Barton in Glen Echo by mistake, just turn LEFT onto MacArthur and proceed up past Seven Locks, past Persimmon Tree, past the David Taylor on your left, to Mountain Gate and turn right. Then continue as explained above.

From Virginia:

Take the 495 Beltway North toward Rockville; take the first exit on the Maryland side. Bear left and merge onto the Clara Barton Parkway going West. Then proceed as above.

From Montgomery County:

Take the 495 Beltway South toward Northern Virginia; take Exit 41, which merges onto the Clara Barton Parkway going West. Then proceed as above.

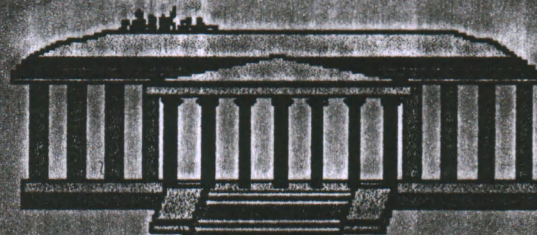

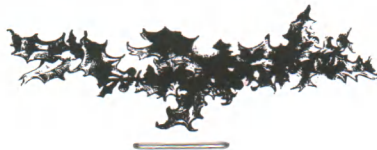

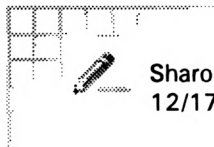
