SUBJECT: 1997 NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL STRATEGY

You are cordially invited to attend a briefing on the *1997 National Drug Control Strategy* to be held 12:30-1:30 p.m., Thursday, February 20, in the 5th Floor Conference Room of ONDCP, 750 17th Street NW, Washington, DC. The President will release the *1997 National Drug Control Strategy* on February 25, and we would like to offer you a preview of the key initiatives.

Members of Congress, Federal, State and local officials, and leaders in the anti-drug community have provided input to the *Strategy*. We think we have a good product that looks ten years out and projects a five-year budget with realistic, measurable goals and objectives. We have a chance now to raise a generation of our children drug-free to adulthood. At the same time we can provide effective treatment, especially for chronic addicts, work to break the cycle of drug use, violence, and crime, protect our borders, and break the drug trafficking organizations. These goals are achievable with a coordinated effort.
