"RAISING THE ASHES"
A Film by Michael O'Keefe

A deeply moving documentary about 150 people who gather at Auschwitz in 1996 to transform the former camp into a place of healing.

"Raising the Ashes" brings together interviews, religious practices and historical footage to create a poignant and powerful film. Reminding us to remember victims and perpetrators of perhaps the greatest crime of the 20th Century. After appreciating Auschwitz as a scene of this crime, the Holocaust, the film demonstrates how it, and places like it, can become a source for healing in our time and for all time.

"Raising the Ashes" is a film which documents an interfaith retreat where participants share a mutual healing in a most unlikely place, a concentration camp. In November of 1996 one hundred and fifty people from seven countries and many different faiths gathered at the Nazi death camp in Auschwitz Poland for five days to come to terms with the dark side of the human spirit and begin to heal through testimonials, prayer and meditation.

The retreat was lead by Roshie Bernie Glassman of the Zen Peacemaker Order of the United States. A social activist and Zen priest for thirty years, Glassman gathered fellow Buddhists, Jews, Muslims and Christians to share in this journey. Glassman planned the retreat with the help of Rabbi Zalman Schacter a leader in Jewish revivalism.

The film documents the participants as they gather for mediation at the "Selection Site" where Joseph Mengele and his staff selected who would live and who would die. There they read names of those killed at the camp.

Following this harrowing account of large scale annihilation, the film introduces the poetry of Ka-Tzetnik 135633. Ka-Tzetnik, a death camp survivor who lives in Israel is also known as Yiheil D'Nur. He is well respected in literary circles for several books about the Holocaust including "Shivitti." A selection from "Shivitti" is read by actor Michael O'Keefe at the ruins of a gas chamber where thousands of people were put to death daily.

Testimonials are an important part of this work. We hear from children of survivors, children of Nazis, Rabbis, Nuns, Priests Poles, Germans, Americans and Europeans, who all have a unique sense of history and perspective to share.

In one of the more evocative interviews Claude Thomas, a Viet Nam veteran and Peacemaker Priest, walks us through an execution at the "Death Wall" where inmates were executed one by one.

The retreat participants walk in the footsteps of the inmates towards Birkenau (Auschwitz 2) tracing the path the inmates were forced to walk on their way to work. Once at the site they gather for religious services lead by different teachers from all four faiths. An important and revealing exchange of feelings and emotions takes place at the "Death Wall" during Kaddish, the Jewish prayer for the dead.

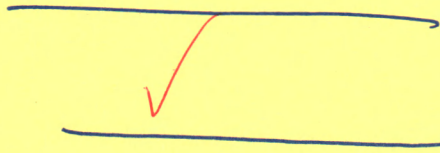
Intricate editorial use of historical footage and a series of montages bring a poignancy to the film and set it apart from other documentaries. Through the use of montage that combines the practices of the retreat with footage of the past we see that Auschwitz is haunted by the people that inhabited the camp and those who put them there. Their presence was keenly felt by everyone and gives this film its spirit and hope.
