The Union Club in New York City, 19 November -- 11:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

It is my pleasure to extend an invitation to you to participate in the next William J. Casey Symposium dealing with an immensely important -- and topical -- issue: the proposed Global Climate Change Treaty (GCCT). As you may know, this treaty, which is expected to be finalized in early December in Kyoto, Japan, is based on two debatable propositions: 1) that the planet is rapidly and potentially catastrophically warming, and 2) that such warming is significantly, if not primarily, attributable to "greenhouse gases" emitted by human consumption of fossil fuels.

The Clinton Administration is convinced that the danger posed by global warming demands swift, even draconian action. Last week, the President unveiled the United States' going-in position on the magnitude and phasing of mandatory reductions in greenhouse gas emissions to be imposed by the Kyoto treaty. While these are not expected to be as deep or rapid as some would like, they will almost certainly affect the U.S. economy, Americans' quality of life and possibly the national security. (With respect to the last, imagine what might happen if the U.S. military -- which produces 73% of all the federal government's greenhouse gas emissions -- were obliged to cut its consumption of fossil fuels by some arbitrary percentage!)

The William J. Casey Institute of the Center for Security Policy exists to consider complex issues like this one, issues that are at the nexus between traditional defense and foreign policy concerns and the increasingly vital problems of the economic, energy and technology security. We are pleased, therefore, to be devoting the afternoon of 19 November to a discussion of "The Implications of the Global Climate Change Treaty for the U.S. Economy, Sovereignty and National Security."

The Symposium -- involving eminent scientists, top industrialists, political leaders, defense and foreign policy experts and members of the national and international press -- will examine critically the "science" of global warming and the wisdom of pursuing a treaty that may or may not affect the planet's climate, but that could have other, far-reaching and potentially undesirable consequences. The proceedings will begin at the **Union Club**, 101 E. 69<sup>th</sup> Street, New York City, at 11:30 a.m. with a luncheon followed by keynote remarks by U.S. Senator **Chuck Hagel (R-NE)** (invited). The Symposium will then proceed from 1:45 to 4:30 p.m. to consider in a round-table format the following areas: scientific issues in a discussion led by **Dr. S. Fred Singer**, formerly Deputy Assistant Administrator for Policy, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and currently President of the Science and Environmental Policy Project in Washington; industrial and economic concerns with lead discussant **David L. Luke, III**, former Chairman and CEO of Westvaco; and a discussion of the GCCT's implications for national security and sovereignty led by **Hon. Malcolm Wallop**, formerly U.S. Senator from Wyoming and now President of the Washington-based **Frontiers of Freedom Institute**.
