My companions of the Warsaw Ghetto
fell in a last heroic battle with their
weapons in their hands. I did not have
the honor to die with them but I belong
to them and to their common grave.

Let my death be an energetic cry of
protest against the indifference of the
world which witnesses the extermination
of the Jewish people without taking any
steps to prevent it. In our day and age
human life is of little value; having failed
to achieve success in my life, I hope that
my death may jolt the indifference of
those who, perhaps even in this extreme
moment, could save the Jews who are
still alive in Poland.

My life belongs to my people in Poland
and that is why I am sacrificing it for
them. May the handful of people who
will survive out of the millions of Polish
Jews achieve liberation in a world of lib.



Szmul Zygielbojm was born in Borowice (Lublin District) on February 21, 1895. After moving to Warsaw he became active in the "Bund," the political expression of the Jewish Socialist Worker's movement.

Following the outbreak of World War II, Zygielbojm helped organize the Bund underground. He also served as the Bund representative to the first Judenrat (Jewish Council) set up by the Germans.

To escape arrest by the Germans, Zygielbojm left Poland in late 1939 and traveled to Belgium, where he worked to compile and disseminate reports to the Polish government and international press on the early persecution of the Jews in Poland.

After making his way to New York, Zygielbojm was sent to London to become a member of the National Council of the Polish Government-in-exile. There he devoted himself to exposing the truth about what was taking place in his homeland, attempting to mobilize international support for the persecuted Jews.

On December 2, 1942, Jan Karski, a courier of the Polish underground, delivered to Zygielbojm a report that was among the first to describe the scope of the mass murder. It contained a list of sites where deportations, forced labor, and mass killing were perpetrated, and estimated that the Germans had already murdered 700,000 Jews.

Upon learning of the deportation of the Jews of Warsaw—among them his wife Manya, and their sixteen-year-old son, Tuvia—Zygielbojm sent a letter to the President of Poland, Wladyslaw Raczekiewicz, and to the Prime Minister, Wladyslaw Sikorski:

"The responsibility for the crime of murdering the entire Jewish population of Poland lies primarily with the murderers themselves, but indirectly it lies with all humanity...I cannot be silent and cannot live when the remnant of the Jewish people in Poland, whom I represent, are dying."

As a final protest against the Nazi atrocities, and the world's indifference to the murder of the Jews, Szmul Zygielbojm committed suicide on May 12, 1943.
