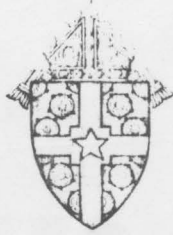

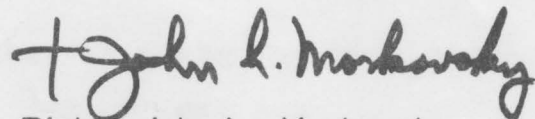

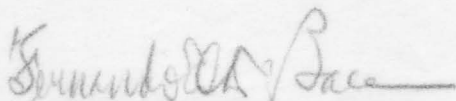

He says he hopes that you will be able to get together on your next visit to the Washington area. He will look forward to that visit.

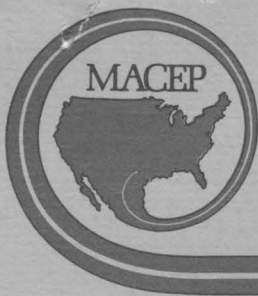

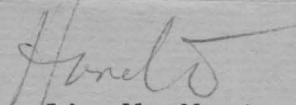
