Brennan's Comments on Various Issues

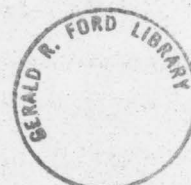

WINEBERGER'S Comments to Various Issues:

We need to eliminate discrimination and segregation and we hope to do that without taking away any federal funds. My policy is to recruit from the outside. Any recommendation will be welcomed. The position shortly will be filled with spanish speaking person, to establish on going communication talk to Nancy Porter and deal with her. Her reports come to me. We'll try to get as many appointees as possible, DeBaca and Armstrong will be very active in recruiting. We will be able to keep you informed on new bills and hearings.

Wineberger was more sensitive to Blacks, has never been close to SSA - Asked for \$3 million for Ed was reduced to under \$3 million. This money not solely for spanish speaking, we don't intend to exclude Blacks.

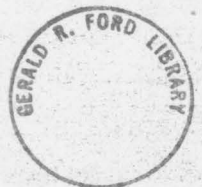

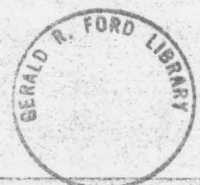

Main Issues Discussed:

National organizations are prepared to suport Cabinet Committee under following conditions



1. advising council should be revised to include the heads of National spanish speaking organizations - purpose for this: to develop accountability on the activities of the staff and to establish better communication and network through organizational structures
2. Chairman of Committee should not be appointed until permanent action takes place with regards to committee's continual existence
3. that a restructuring take place which would:
 - a. make chairman as well as staff members to Hatch Act
 - b. that its main purpose be redefined to indicate that research and evaluation is emphasized.

Maduro requested support for Cabinet Committee in present form stating that continuing existence was necessary before any other action. National Hispanic leaders joint decision for full support and endorsement of the extension of CCOSSP was on the condition that at least 6 members of the National organizations' leaders be immediately appointed to serve on the Advisory Council of CCOSSP.

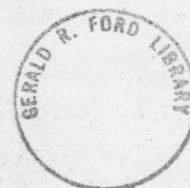

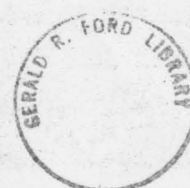

Issue executive order telling them to concentrate on those mandates which help Spanish speaking.

Met with Rodubush: Concerned with appointments, super-grades. We have determined that we will work together to respond to needs of Spanish speaking - Rodabuch responded. Join together all Latinos.

Frank - American Revo. Bicentennial Adm. - Corp. of Public Broadcasting. 440 grants - less than 30 to minorities and 4 or 5 are Latinos. Still not one Spanish speaking on board. Recommended at least one or two.

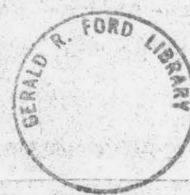
Joe Benites - Look at percentages of .1, .5, etc. in Spanish speaking jobs.

Ed Valenzuela, Hampton, Brennan said they would help - not enough executive order to enforce Spanish-speaking program.

Raul Yzaguirre - Not concerned of La Raza policy - Concerning Census Bureau - not counting us properly; few members finally admitted that. Concerning documents - Social Indicators does not include Spanish speaking. Policies are being made from the figure in this document. Programming do away with local initiative.

Benetes - Median number of Spanish speaking - 22,000,000,000 buying power aiming at private industries

Aceves - LAMA address to Latinos in business. Administration has not taken steps to develop Spanish-speaking economic base - Alaska pipe line not getting enough support from Department of Interior; as of now no contract to Latinos.



Benetes - Revenue Sharing - wiped out program in communication.

Villa - Manpower - difficulty with administration - we're not getting fair share - very few Spanish-speaking commissioners. Committee of Aging and Committee of Labor which would like to see them given to us.

Zazueta - SER, first time in this included. Still discrimination; not responding to law. Title II limited to English speaking. They are ignoring the law. Talked to Brennan and Wineburger on bilingual education - not putting enough responsiveness and accountability into agencies.

Question: What do you think of President meeting with Spanish-speaking congress.

Tony - Nice gesture - only two individuals have monies. Appointments are diminishing. Ambassador to Spain has been taken by non-Spanish speaking.

Benetes - They have met with Black Committee 15 times - we want same consideration.

Question: Problem of interest.

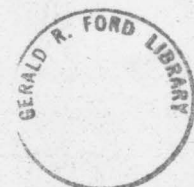
Ed Valenzuela - IMAGE filed 3rd party complaints; four agencies not providing equal EO. Department of Interior did not respond and hearings were set - respond was bad - they admitted it was a racial agency, not moving in EEO. I feel one agency should provide equal opportunity and access to jobs.

Question: Bicentennial?

Frank - Involvement of commission in heritage and looking for one Spanish-speaking individual there.

Benetes - Using Bicentennial to fund sewage highway instead to push cultural program which are paid out of this program.

Tony - Sensitized to needs of committee - we need to have individuals who are aware of us in the agency - once in there we can determine our policy to help Spanish speaking. HEW Civil Rights and EEO should be forming compliance.



Question: Will this group meet again?

Zazueta -- Yes, we want a follow-up.

Mannie -- One group will meet every three months here in Washington.

Tony: If and when we meet with President, set some standards and time tables. We need some Spanish-speaking undersecretaries.

Zazueta -- Declaration of Heritage Week -- We don't want to be remembered one week; we want 52 weeks of remembering.
