The program will begin at 1:00. An agenda is in the mail with a special delivery letter confirming your reservations as their guest at the Houston Oaks.

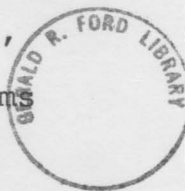
The dinner will be at the Red Carpet Inn 7611 Katie Avenue, or Street.
