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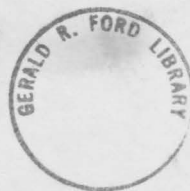

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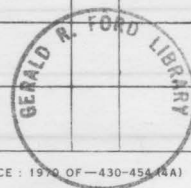

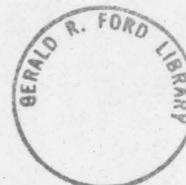

I've just returned from a week-long trip to Chicago and the West Coast and wanted to take this early opportunity to thank you for your very able and kind assistance during my visit to Chicago.

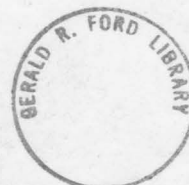

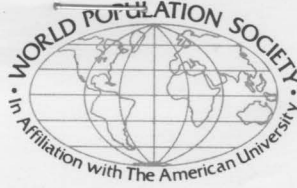

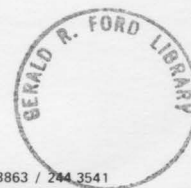
