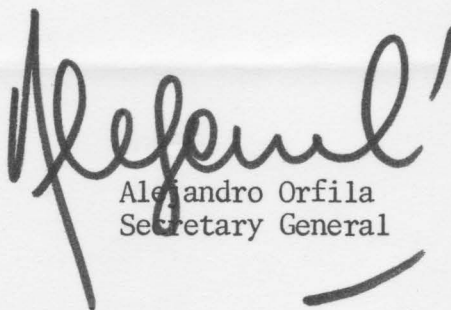

Thank you for your generosity in sending me a copy of your letter dated November 5, 1975 to Ambassador John Jova.

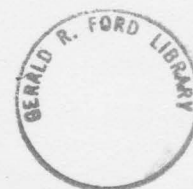

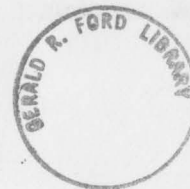
