SUMMARY REPORT

YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1975

Income. Total income was \$83,263.47. Of this amount, \$33,173.90 was from private contributions and \$50,000 from a contract with the City of Los Angeles (Model Cities). Detailed income report is attached.

A contract with the State of California in the amount of \$187,837 was successfully negotiated. This will fund a "Youth Summer Work Experience Program" during July, August, and September, 1975 for 165 college-bound students from low-income homes in the greater Los Angeles area. Report No. 1 is attached.

Grants. Scholarship grants were awarded to 120 students for the college year beginning in September 1975. List of recipients is attached.

College Opportunity Program. YOF helped 418 seniors from central and east Los Angeles high schools with a program of services designed to help them get into college. Services included tutoring and counseling, payment of college test and admissions fees, college orientation and trips, college fair, payment for books (dictionaries, thesauri, etc.), English and writing skills seminars and help in securing financial aid.

This activity was funded by \$50,000 from Los Angeles Model Cities, \$7,379 from YOF funds and \$48,300 in 'in-kind' contributions from industry and schools. Complete reports are available upon request.

Financial Aid: \$1.5+ Million. YOF helped 254 students win California State Scholarships, state College Opportunity Grants and federal Basic Opportunity Grants. These grants have an aggregate value in excess of \$1.5 million. This activity was part of the College Opportunity Program described above. List of winners is attached.
