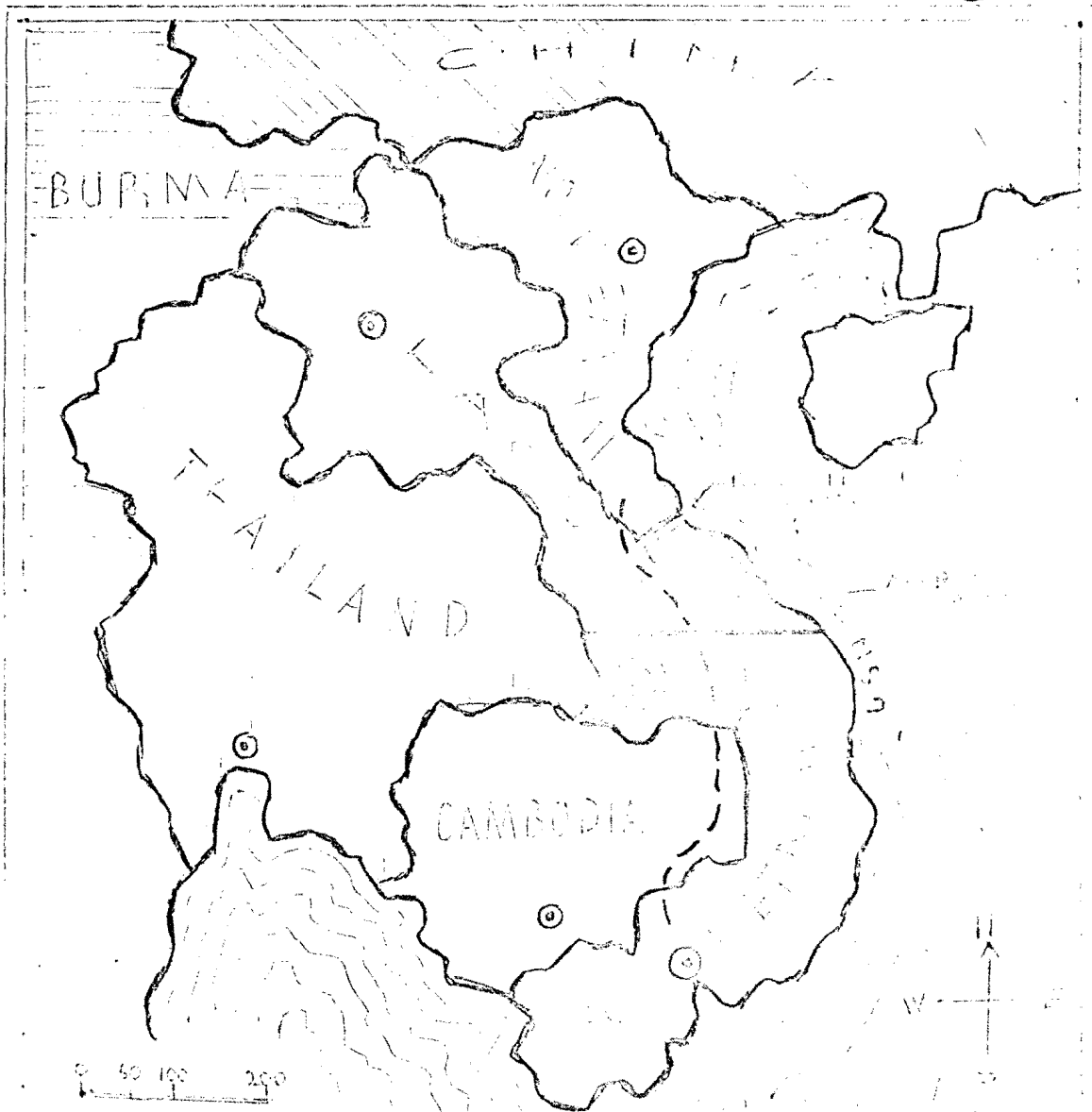

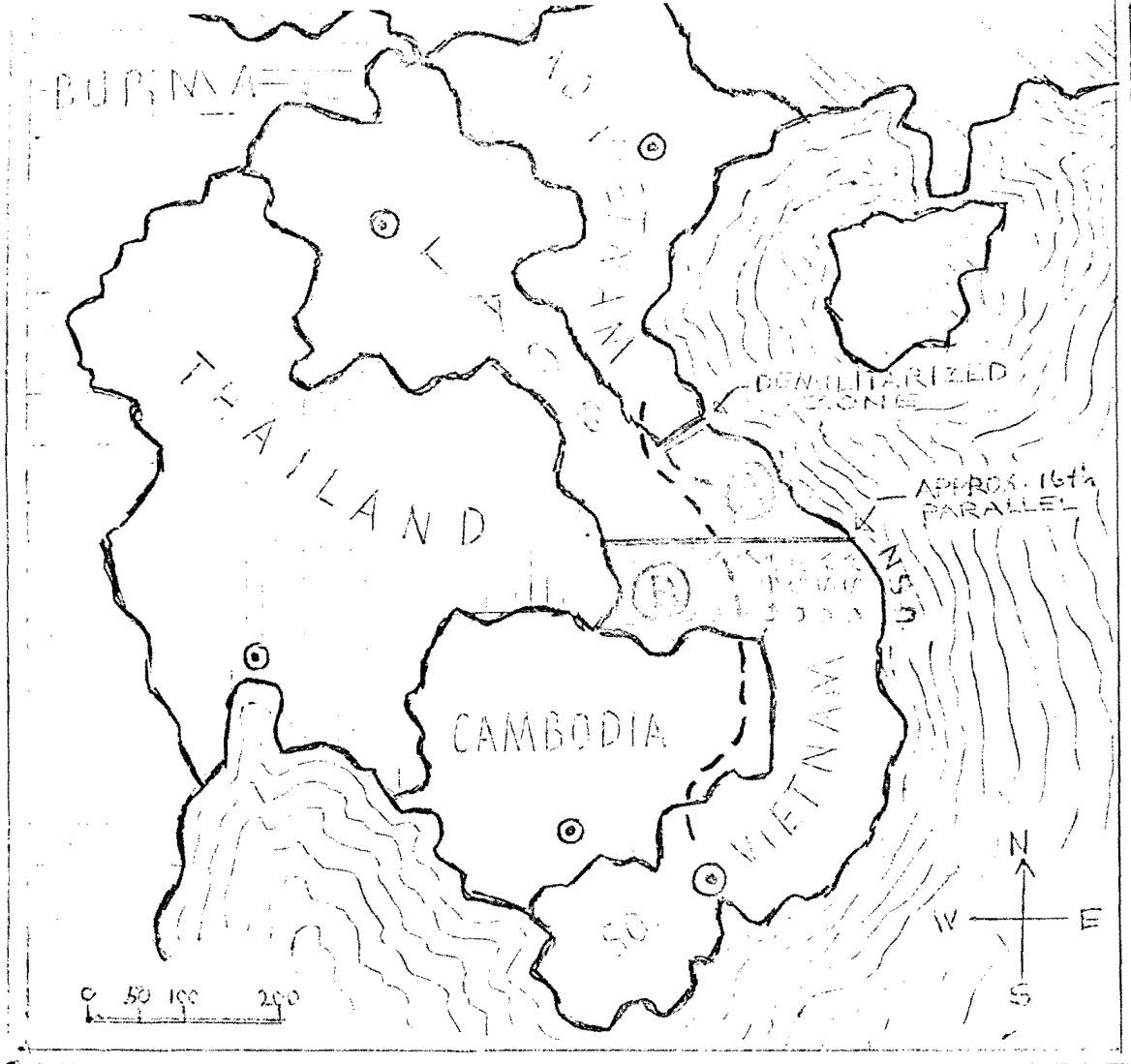

around us that day! Our Dr. advised immediate treatment for Chemotherapy injections under Dr. Francis Bull at the University of Mich. Hospital in Ann Arbor, Mich.

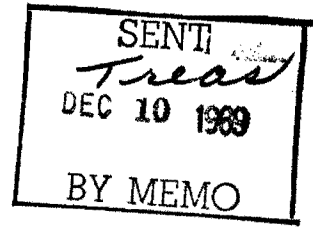

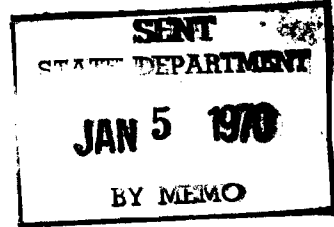

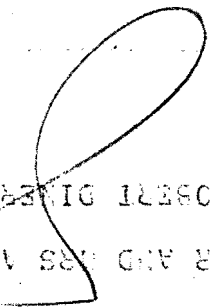
