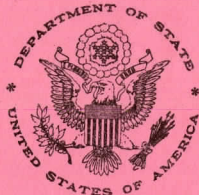

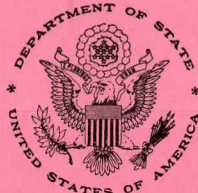

After talking with him, Tony<sup>x</sup> Marshall has agreed to accept the offer of the Ambassadorship to Malagasy. However, before doing so, he asked that he would have an opportunity to speak to Under Secretaries Richardson and Johnson regarding a subsequent opportunity to serve as ambassador to one of five countries, subject to his performance in Malagasy being satisfactory and no serious problem arising from his former CIA connections. These five countries are Tanzania, Kenya, Ethiopia, Nigeria, and Uganda. He of course will serve enthusiastically in Malawi.

I checked this with Secretary Richardson, who agreed. I have so informed Anthony<sup>x</sup> Marshall and he will make his plans accordingly. He looks forward to the opportunity to sit down with Secretary Richardson and Johnson.

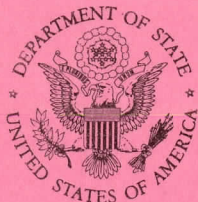
