SUBJECT: Your Meeting with Gromyko: Draft Talking Points

Although you have already seen some of the talking points suggested for your meeting with Gromyko, attached is a package of draft points covering the three anticipated segments of the meeting: your initial presentation (Tab A); your responses to the major points Gromyko can be expected to make, including some concrete suggestions for progress on specific issues (Tab B), and the points I showed you earlier for an unscheduled private interlude with Gromyko (Tab C).

Obviously, we will have to adjust these points to reflect specific decisions you will be making and also to take account of Gromyko's meeting with George Shultz and his UN address, now scheduled for September 27. But this package will give an idea of the overall concept of the meeting as we envision it at this point.
