As you log trips you will qualify for the Smart Trips Discount Card with valuable discounts throughout Whatcom County. 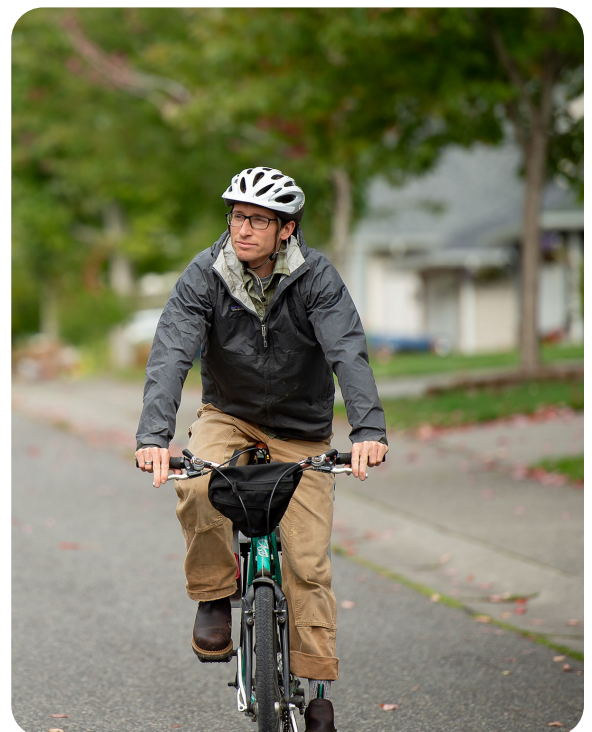
Facilities for Bicyclists and Walkers

If you live within 3 miles of work, you could bike here in 15-20 minutes! It only takes around 5 minutes to ride 1 mile and 15-20 minutes to walk a mile. What a great way to get more physical activity into your routine. Ask our Smart Trips Rep for a map showing biking and walking routes. They can also show you the location of our bike parking and any other amenities.

Free Smart Trips Bike Classes

If you are new to bicycle commuting, Smart Trips offers free private bike classes for any skill level. They can help you find a safe route to work and show you how to handle any tricky intersections with ease.
