Building the Future on Two Decades of Achievement

To our Members:

It has been an incredible year!

Throughout 2025, AgGateway celebrated its 20th anniversary of promoting, enabling, and expanding principled, standards-based data exchange among stakeholders in the international agriculture industry. Our watch words, Create, Engage, and Grow, guided our efforts as we collaboratively developed resources and relationships necessary to enable the electronic exchange of business and operational data.

And, as we conclude the 2021-2025 5-year plan, we do so with stable membership and resource implementation, an energized and geographically distributed group of volunteers, and a solid financial base on which to move into 2026.

In 2025, AgGateway staff and volunteers:

- Led six working groups addressing issues of particular concern to members, including revisions to grower and farm business identification rules in AGIIS, updating code lists and the schema for laboratory testing standards, and documenting processes and data for field operations such as crop protection application and obstacle identification for autonomy
- Engaged in international standards development in ISO TC 347 Datadriven Agrifood Systems, through a Category A liaison relationship, enabling both influence and awareness to promote existing resources and protect the investments members have already made in interoperability
- Published the second version of ADAPT Standard, which has been implemented
 or is planned to be implemented by OEMs and farm management platforms
 engaged in sharing data through standardized formats
- Participated in 23 conferences, making presentations on standards in agriculture, championing AgGateway resources, including ADAPT, PAIL, and Modus, and engaging members and member prospects through side meetings and in-person visits

Our marketing and communications efforts this year included the launch of the "Inside AgGateway" webinar series, which informed and educated more than 400 industry stakeholders on existing AgGateway standards and resources over six virtual installments. We produced a 20th anniversary video, released for the 2025 Annual Meeting and Conference, highlighting the value AgGateway has contributed to the industry and teasing the work we still have to accomplish. And more than 280 attendees participated in person at AgGateway conferences across three continents.

As we move into our 21st year, we will pursue implementation of existing and new resources, document the impact they have to members and the industry, and advocate for standards-based data exchange as a valuable tool for achieving business efficiency. The relationships and resources we develop are certain to accelerate solutions to the practical problems of today while laying the groundwork for agile responses to tomorrow's challenges.

Thank you for your dedication of time and talent to AgGateway in 2025, and we look forward to another year of achievement in interoperability and connectivity across the value chain.


