THE JUNE MEETING OF THE AARC will be held in the meeting room of the AUSTIN NATURAL SCIENCE CENTER, at 201 Deep Eddy, at 7:30 pm, Tuesday, June 8th, 1971. If you are not familiar with the location, take 1st or 6th street west from Lamar to Lake Austin Blvd. Continue on Lake Austin Blvd until a large ENCO sign is seen on the right and a large 66 sign is seen on the left. Deep Eddy street is a small street that runs down toward the lake (to your left when going west) directly across from the ENCO station and just before you get to the 66 station. There is also a little Bar with a mirror on the door on the corner.

THE PROGRAM FOR THE EVENING will be the discussion, and final preparation for FIELD DAY and the VHF QSO PARTY. George Luce, WA5SPN, will bring his 2 meter SSB Transverter, and Bob Lamb, WA5ZXC, will bring some of his 435MHz and 1200MHz gear for you to ponder over and get generally enlightened.

THE FIELD-DAY SITE FOR THIS YEAR will be the camp grounds at the Georgetown Municipal Airport. The site has some excellent possibilities which we intend to exploit. There are many trees for shade, and a big hangar which we could all operate from should the weather get bad. There is a 40 ft. crank-up tower and a tri-band beam available should we care to erect it and plenty of space for long antennas, too. Jim Boutwell, W5LDA, who is the Airport Manager, invited us and will assist us while we are there.

"NEMO", W5SD, is getting the gear ready for the Novice Station for Field-Day. He has a new DX-60B, which he has assembled and put in best working order, 3 Novice band crystals (40 Meters), and W5RJA's "Mohawk" receiver. All we need now is an Antenna, a change-over relay, and a flock of eager Novices to operate the station. Let's hear from you at the meeting Tuesday.

The site for the VHF QSO Party has not been selected yet, but maps have been studied and some sites have been looked over.

6 Meter activity was really good during the weekend of 31 May 1971. George, WA5SPN, worked 16 states, including: Fresno, Calif., Atlanta, Ga., Harrisburg, Pa., and Casper, Wyo., to name a few. Let's hope we get openings like that during the QSO Party.

It has been reported that K5HWE, of San Antonio, will be in Mexico during the QSO Party weekend and will be on 6 & 2 meter SSB using the call: XE2FF. From Nuevo Laredo. He will be looking for QSO's with W5KA, as well as others, while there.
