

While all efforts are made to keep this information current, all published rules shall be considered unofficial. Official rules will be distributed and announced at the registration check-in and captains meeting. All participants agree to the terms of these rules by participating in the tournament.

SCRUB ISLAND BILLFISH SERIES RULES, AWARDS AND OPTIONAL JACKPOTS
LEG 1 – AUGUST 24 - 28, 2026 & LEG 2 – AUGUST 28 - SEPTEMBER 1, 2026

ENTRY

Boats competing in the Scrub Island Billfish Series Leg 1 (August 24 - 28, 2026) and/or Leg 2 (August 28 - September 1, 2026) are eligible for 2026 Series trophies and awards. Teams may also enter the optional Scrub Island Billfish Series Jackpots for additional cash prizes.

RULES

All participants must follow the rules of each individual tournament leg. Boats may compete with different anglers at each event. Series standings are based on the combined total of points earned across both legs. The boat with the highest total points wins the series. Boats are not required to fish both legs to be entered in the series. In the event of a tie, the boat that reached the highest point total first will be declared the winner.

SCORING

Each leg follows the same billfish scoring system and the points accumulate across both events:

- Blue marlin release: 500 points
- White marlin, spearfish, and sailfish release: 100 points

AWARDS

This is a boat championship series. The boat with the highest total points will receive the series trophy and prize package.

SCRUB ISLAND BILLFISH SERIES JACKPOT

\$5000

The fee to enter the Scrub Island Billfish Series Overall Points Jackpot is \$5,000 and is optional. Teams must be registered by 7:29 am on their first day of fishing to be eligible for the Scrub Island Billfish Series Overall Points Jackpot. The Scrub Island Billfish Series Optional Points Jackpot will be awarded to the top three teams with the most overall points of the two event (leg) series and will be awarded accordingly; First place 50%, Second Place 30%, Third Place 20%. Only teams entered in the optional jackpot are eligible for these cash awards.

AWARDS PRESENTATION

Series winners will be recognized at the awards presentation on September 1, 2026, at Scrub Island Resort & Marina.
