SPRING PLANT DATES

• For RP/YP policies, replant coverage attaches for each crop planted for the first time on or after the dates listed in the maps below. Standard replant claims will be paid at:



NOTE: You must replant the lesser of 20% of the unit or 20 acres before replant coverage kicks in. It is imperative that you submit a "Notice of Loss" PRIOR to replanting.

• Late reporting of replant notices <u>WILL</u> result in the claim being denied.

FAILED WHEAT

- Attention!
- If you are planning to destroy your insured wheat, it must be appraised by an adjuster prior to termination. Contact your agent or our office immediately to submit a claim if your wheat crop is in question.
- Your agent can review your options when planting a second crop following failed wheat.

COVER CROPS

• A cover crop must be terminated within 5 days after planting or before crop emergence (whichever is first) for the Spring crop to be insured.

2022 Production

• If you have not submitted your 2022 corn and soybean production, it is due to our office no later than April 29th, 2023.
