

# **HANDLING**


Carry boxes and screens upright.





Keep all surfaces clean for storage and fabrication.





Store boxes and screens flat.






Store in a cool, dry place with no direct sun. Avoid 145 degree temperatures or greater.






Wear gloves for handling light colors.





Upon delivery, inspect all goods for order corrections and damage.






Keep product dry and avoid humidity.





Protect the edges.





### **PRODUCT NOTES**

### **EchoScreen Cutout Removal**

After the screens are installed, remove the precut cutouts by hand. Support back of screens firmly, and press out cutout shapes by hand using gentle firm pressure with finger or blunt instrument such as the eraser end of a pencil. Do not put excessive pressure on unsupported screens in order to avoid creasing. If the cutout shape is not fully cut through, an Exacto-type blade may be used to cut any remaining material.

#### **Standoffs**


Standoffs can be used for installing screens and is an available hardware option when ordering screens. To use this installation method for a project, request standoffs when specifying and Kirei will provide custom instructions for each screen style used. Some screens require design changes to accommodate for stand offs.


### **Alternative Installation Hardware**

Kirei has multiple alternative ways to install EchoScreen based on spacial needs; however, these alternative installation variations may require extra hardware at an additional cost. Contact Kirei for more information.

### **Abutting Screens**

Abutting screens capability depends on the style of screen. Screens with a rectangular shape, much like the Classic Screens, are ones that can abut. All other Kirei screens do not have the capability to abut.





# **PRODUCT NOTES**

### 4+ EchoScreen Installation

When installing 4 or more abutted (sequential) EchoScreens, even numbers of panels will include 66" Channel Tracks for each end and 42" Channel Tracks for the center panels. Odd numbers of screens will include a 66" Channel track for each end and 90" Channel Tracks for the center panels.






### Repeatability/Mirroring

Screens can be installed in a continuous repeating pattern or mirrored pattern. See the examples below.








# **Channel Track Lengths**






NOTE: Not all tools are needed for installation, but depending on install choice, could be used.

- A. (1) Channel Track
- B. (2) 1/4"-20 Male Threaded Screws
- C. (2) Eyebolts and (2) Hex Nuts
- D. (2) Mounting Screws
- E. (2) Square Nut

# STANDARD HANGING INSTALLATION

EchoScreen is most commonly installed through the standard hanging method. Screens can be hung individually or arrayed in groups, either in repeated or mirrored patterns.



Clean and prepare surface. Then, attach channel track.

Insert square nuts into channel track, and use the set screw or the eyebolt depending on what was chosen for the cable attachment. Set screws require 4mm hex tool and should be turned until fully tightened.

Add the suspension cable/chain/rod/etc to the screen attachments, and then fasten appropriate attachments to the screen hardware. Note: Ceiling mounting hardware, suspension items, and pendant attachments are not included.


Once the ceiling hardware is installed, attach the connector to the supplied attachment hardware and level the screen/s.

# **ROLLING TRACK INSTALLATION**

Rolling tracks can be installed in continuous runs or side-by-side for bypass or overlapping screens. Rolling tracks are clear anodize architectural grade aluminum and can be cut to length on-site.



Clean and prepare surface. Install the rolling track(s) on the ceiling as specified for the project. Due to variation in ceiling structure and local code, Kirei does not provide mounting fasteners or direction for this step.



Slide the square nut into the channel track, keeping the nylon washer on the top and the square nut inside the track. Using the hex tool, position each carrier.

Determine the specified range of travel for each screen and mount the stoppers within the rolling track using the provided fasteners.

### **DIRECT MOUNT INSTALLATION**

EchoScreens can be adhered to walls and ceiling using adhesive. The recommended adhesives to use with EchoScreens include Loctite PowerGrab Construction Adhesive, Loctite PL 3X Premium Construction Adhesive, Liquid Nails LN903 Heavy-Duty Construction Adhesive, AFM Safecoat Almighty Adhesive (solvent free solution), and ChemLink BuildSecure Construction Adhesive (solvent free solution). **Do not use PVA Glue for an adhesive for PET screens.** 





Clean and prepare surface per adhesive guidelines. Then, apply adhesive evenly on tile back, leaving 3" of space between outer edges of screen and any cutouts.



Adhere to wall surface per layout and maintain even pressure per adhesive manufacturer time and instructions. Clean off any excess adhesive.

Note: Some styles can't use glue.





### MECHANICAL FASTENERS INSTALLATION


EchoScreens can be fastened to surfaces using mechanical fasteners such as nails, screws or staples where appropriate. Ensure proper fasteners to match substrate are used. The benefit of using mechanical attachments is that they can be removed completely without leaving residue in order to allow the screens to be recycled fully. Don't over tighten fasteners to avoid denting or pillowing the screen surface and don't use self-tapping screws to hang large screens. Nails or screws should be fastened into battens or suitable substrates.




Clean and prepare surface. Hardware placement to be determined per project. Drilled holes should be slightly oversized to allow for thermal expansion and contraction. Insure drilled holes have smooth edges.



Fasten screen to wall surface per layout. Use washers for better load distribution and to prevent pull-through. Also, use metal inserts if frequent assembly/ reassembly is required.
