

How To: Enter Weaning Data

Step One:


The member login can be accessed from www.wagyu.org by clicking on the 'Digital Beef Sign In' icon at the top of the screen.

Note: The 'Members Only' tab is used for viewing board meeting minutes.



Step Two:


Once you are logged into Digital Beef you will click 'View' in the left-hand menu to bring up your General Profile Information page. Next you will click on the 'Herd' tab.





Step Three:

When the Herd tab is selected, a series of boxes will appear where you can select a filter to apply to your herd list. Clicking the All tab will bring up a list of all active animals in your herd. In the Wean Column, click on the available box next to each calf you wish to enter weaning data for to add them to your Weaning Work Queue.




Note: If the animal does not have a box in the Wean column it means the animal is less than 100 days old, and the record may need to be entered manually. For animals less than 100 days of age, go to Herd Mgmt/Recording/Weaning. Enter the number of animals to be entered, click Continue and follow the 'Entering Weaning Data' steps.



Step Four:

Go to the Weaning Data Entry Screen by clicking on Work Queues and selecting 'Weaning.'



Step Five:

In the Weaning Queue, click the "Go to this Queue" button for the desired work order in progress to open the data entry table.





Step Six:

Enter the weaning information for the animal:


- Weaning Date
- Hip Height
- Dam Status
- Weaning Weight
- Hip Height Date
- Dam Weight and Hip Height
- Temperament
- Current Status
- Dam Body Condition



Step Seven:

Once all the data is entered, click on the 'Validate' button located below the last calf line. You must validate before leaving this screen, otherwise all the data entered will be lost. Once you have validated, and no errors remain, select 'Commit to Registry' to commit the weaning record to the calf.

The weaning data will now display under the Performance Tab of this animal's Detail Screen in Digital Beef.



Note: If you have a calf in your work queue that you do not have data for, you can delete that animal from the work queue by clicking on the red 'X' at the right most column of the screen. That animal will be removed and weaning data can be entered later.
