Biblical Typology

<i>Abraham</i>	as the father who was leading
<i>Sarah</i>	as her death is a type of Israel's slumber (spiritually)
<i>Isaac</i>	as the obedient son even unto death
<i>Eliazer</i>	as the comforter, Holy Spirit to draw out a bride
<i>Rebekah</i>	as the church ( a servant / bride ) given gifts <i>and then taken by the H.S. into a far country</i>

To the son of promise was given "ALL that He had"

Verses 7-8

A Direct reference to the place of those beyond the grave,  
the place of the living.

*Double-doors*

**HEB;** the place of double, *two*-doors, to leave one, and enter another  
( *The story of the rich man and Lazarus* )

Luke 16:19-31

*Hell*

haides (hah'-dace)

*properly, unseen, i.e. "Hades" or the place  
(state) of departed souls: grave, hell.*

## *The Thief on the Cross;*

**Luke 23:43**

**And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly,  
I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."**

*Paradise*

*paradeisos (par-ad'-i-sos)*

*a park, an Eden*

*(place of happiness, "paradise")*

***When Jesus died***

*he descended into this Hades or*

*Abraham Bosom " a place of comfort and protection*

***When the Old Testament saints Died, they went to Paradise***

**Ephesians 4:8-10**

**"When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men.**

**<sup>9</sup> (Now this, "He ascended" -- what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? <sup>10</sup> He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)**

**1 Peter 3:18-19**

**For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison**

**PRIOR TO THE CROSS**

**Those who died in faith went to Brahma's bosom**

- *Ripped in spots*
- *It smells and it's getting' stiff*

*The feast of Tabernacles (of being temporary)*

**Christians are the only, true,  
Upwardly Mobile People**

*This Body is wearying out;*

*We Love to Camp*

*I used to say " what kind of a Idiot would come this far out into the country and stay in the Lodge... This kind of Idiot now!!!*

**2 Corinthians 5:1-2**

For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. <sup>2</sup> For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven,

Our New Bodies;

**John 14:2**

"In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

( Here, Try this on )

*What Happens When we die ?*

**2 Corinthians 5:6, 8 NKJV**

So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. <sup>8</sup> We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

Verse:22

*Is God Fair?*

*God has foreknowledge prior to His election,  
Based upon that, He predestined*

## Esau was a Natural Man. Interested in the things of the earth

### **Romans 9:10-13**

*And not only this; but when Rebecca also had conceived by one, even by our father Isaac; <sup>11</sup> (For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;) <sup>12</sup> It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger. <sup>13</sup> As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.  
( Have Loveless )*

### Verse 27

Jacob was a (tam) a complete, perfect man  
Romans 14:4

*Jacob was a sneaky guy, But the Lord never put him down  
I am to never put you down and condemn you*

Esau, was a hunter (like nimrod) and a fornicator (having sex outside of marriage)

### Verse 31

*Jacob desired the Birthright*

**Yet it is even worse for Esau to despise the birth right,**

*The spiritual life was rejected by Esau*

*Turn to Hebrews 12*

### **Hebrews 12:12-17**

Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; <sup>13</sup> And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. <sup>14</sup> Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: <sup>15</sup> Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled; <sup>16</sup> Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright. <sup>17</sup> For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it
