

DEFINING BIBLICAL TYPOLOGY

Typology: a person, office, place, institution, event, or thing in salvation history that anticipates, shares correspondences with, escalates toward, and resolves in Jesus

PSALMS

1/ David was a suffering king, just as Jesus was a suffering King.

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" Psalm 22:1, NIV

Matthew 27:46

2/ David was a victorious king, just as Jesus is a victorious King.

Psalm 72:8-11

...at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:10-11, NIV

PROVERBS

1/ Proverbs personified wisdom, just as Jesus personifies wisdom.

Proverbs 8

It is because of Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God. 1 Corinthians 1:30, NIV

ECCLESIASTES

1/ Solomon was a teacher of wisdom, just as Jesus is the teacher of wisdom.

I, the Teacher, was king over Israel in Jerusalem. I applied my mind to study and to explore by wisdom all that is done under the heavens. Ecclesiastes 1:12-13, NIV

Matthew 7:29

SONG OF SOLOMON

1/ The man loved his bride, just as Jesus loves His bride.

Tell me, you whom I love... Song of Solomon 1:7, NIV

Ephesians 5:25-32

ISAIAH

1/ Isaiah spoke of a virgin birth, as seen in Mary's life.

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a Son, and will call Him Immanuel. Isaiah 7:11, NIV

Matthew 1:23

JEREMIAH

1/ Jeremiah was set apart, just as Jesus was set apart.

The word of the Lord came to me, saying, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations." Jeremiah 1:4-5, NIV

John 18:37

LAMENTATIONS

1/ Jerusalem was found in judgment, just as the lost will be found in judgment.

He has hurled down the splendor of Israel... Lamentations 2:1, NIV

Revelation 21

EZEKIEL

1/ Ezekiel prophesied new life out of death, just as Jesus brings people to new life out of death.

Ezekiel 37

But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. Ephesians 2:4-5, NIV

DANIEL

1/ The fourth man saved the Hebrew men from the fire, just as Jesus saves us from the fire.

He said, "Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed, and the fourth looks like a son of the gods." Daniel 3:25, NIV

Matthew 25:31-34

2/ Daniel willingly faced death, just as Jesus willingly faced death.

Daniel 6:17-23

Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given Me?" John 18:11, NIV
