Praying for My Workplace

1. Pray for positive relationships at work. Ask the Lord to remove traps of comparison and any rivalry mentality on your job and replace it with cooperative hearts who focus on the greater good of the company.
2. Pray for joyful attitudes. Ask the Lord to help you to be intentional about communicating a positive attitude that it may bring healing and consistent encouragement to those with whom you work.
3. Pray for anointing to be able to represent His character and nature well. Ask for a greater understanding of your role within your workplace. “Lord Jesus, give strength and wisdom to help me complete my work with excellence. Make me a bold witness so others may turn to you!”
4. Thank the Lord for your job and commit to working as unto Him and not as unto man. Ask the Holy Spirit to give your team energy to tackle problems with grace and to keep your minds clear from any distractions that would hinder excellent work and productivity.
5. Ask for insight from the Holy Spirit on how to deal with colleagues who have negative attitudes, a poor work ethic, or who are gossips or unkind. Then make every effort to do what leads to peace and building others up.
